HAVE BEGUN THIS COMPUTERIZED VERSION IN NOVEMBER 2016. There were some text errors in the earlier versions, due to lack of sufficient research material when I first typed it. I have stated that this will be an ongoing work, and whenever new knowledge is available, and would make changes necessary, they would be made. Nothing is more important than accuracy when dealing with Scripture.

"Deuteronomy" is translated as "Second Law" in the Septuagint, but the actual name of the book is "These Are The Words" - Elleh 428 Debariym 1697 plural. The book begins with these words, and thus the Hebrew title for the book. This is not a "second law", but a repetition of what Mosheh had said to Yisrael previously. An entirely new generation had arisen in Yisrael, and the old one had perished in the wilderness. The new folks needed to hear these words, and Mosheh wrote them down, and the scroll was placed in the Ark of the Covenant.

As in the other four books of Mosheh, proper names will be in the transliteration format, as they are spelled in Hebrew. If you want the KJV spelling, refer to your KJV. I will not indicate Masoretic vowel points, as they are often in error, and varied from scribe to scribe as to spelling. They were for help in pronunciation, but the scribes changed much of the text to hide the Holy Name of Yahweh. They substituted #136 adonay for The Name, because of Jewish "tradition". I have indicated where this has occurred in the margin notes, and have replaced the Name of Yahweh where it belongs.

Chapter notes are mine, and you may agree or disagree as you please. I am Yisrael Identity in belief, and Scripture firmly supports this. If you think you have found error, look it up for yourself. My research material is as follows -

Complete Word Study Old Testament, and the Dictionary for it (AMG Publishers) Brown, Driver, Briggs, Gesenius Hebrew/English Lexicon (Hendrickson Publishers) Strong's Exhaustive Concordance (Nelson Publishers)

A Tanak for the Hebrew (J.P.S.). The JPS Tanak is the most accurate I could find as to the Hebrew, but anything published by Jews needs careful examination. Their "English translation" is an absolute fraud. It does not even approach saying what the Hebrew says, so don't even bother with it.

Words that are <u>underlined</u> are one word in the Hebrew, even though several words are used in English. Strong's numbers will follow words where needed in italics, but I will only do this a few times, and then only the word will be used.

Introduction

Chapter 1

1. These 428 are the words 1697 that spoke 1696 Mosheh 4872 to all Yisrael 3478 on this side of the Yarden 3383 in the wilderness 4057, in the plain 6160 near the Sea of Reeds 5489, between Paran 6290, and Tophel 8603, and Laban 3837, and Chatseroth 2698, and Diy Zahab 1744.

2. Eleven days from Choreb 2722 by the way of Mount Seiyr 8165 to Qadesh-Barnea 6947.

3. And it was in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month 2320, on the first of the month, that **spoke** Mosheh to the children of Yisrael, according to all that commanded 6680 Yahweh him to them;

4. after he had smitten *5221* Siychon *5511* king of the Emoriy *567*, who dwelled in Cheshbon *2809*, and Og *5747*, king of Bashan *1316*, who dwelled at Ashtaroth *6252* in Edreiy *154*:

5. On this side of the Yarden, in the land of Moab *4124*, began Mosheh to declare *874* this Torah *8451*, saying,

6. "Yahweh Eloheynu 430 spoke to us in Choreb, saying, 'Long 7227 have you dwelled on this mountain:

7. turn 6437, and set forth 5265, and go 935 to the mountain of the Emoriy, and to all neighboring places 7934 in the plain, in the <u>hill country</u> 2022, and in the valley 8219, and in the Negeb 5045, and by the shore 2348 of the sea 3220, to the land of the Kenaaniy 3669, and into Lebanon 3844, to the great 1419 river 5104 Perath 6578.

8. See 7200, I have given you the land before you: go and possess 3423 the land that swore 7650 Yahweh to your forefathers 1, Ab'raham 85, Yitschaq 3327, and Yaaqob 3290, to give to them and their seedline 2233 after them."

9. and I spoke to you at that time, saying, 'I am not able alone 905 to bear 5375 you:

10. Yahweh Eloheychem 430 has multiplied 7235 you, and behold 2009 you are this day as the stars 3556 of the sky 8064 for multitude 7230.

11. Yahweh Elohey 430 your forefathers *l* make you a thousand times more than you are, and bless you, as He has said to you!

12. How 349 can I bear alone the responsibility 2960 for your burden 4853, and your strife 7379?

13. Provide *3051* men of wisdom *2450*, discerning *995*, and known *3045* from among your tribes *7626*, and I will appoint *7760* them as heads *7218* over you.'

14. And you answered 6030 me, and said, 'It is good 2896 the thing which you have spoken to do.'

15. So I took the heads of your tribes, men of wisdom, and known, and put them as heads over you, magistrates *8269* over thousands, and magistrates over hundreds, and magistrates over fifties, and magistrates over tens, and officers *7860* among your tribes.

16. And I commanded *6680* your judges *8199* at that time, saying, 'Hear between your kinsmen *251*, and judge righteously *6664* between a man *376* and his kinsman, and between the sojourner *1616*.

17. You shall not be partial to 5234 to presence 6440 in judgement 4941; the small 6996 and the great 1419 you shall hear; you shall not fear 1481 the presence of a man; because the judgement is Elohiym's 430: and if a matter 1697 is too difficult 7185, bring 7126 it to me, and I will hear it.'

18. And I commanded you at that time all the things which you should do.

19. And when we set out from Choreb, we went through all that great and awesome *3372* wilderness, which you saw by the way of the mountain of the Emoriy, as Yahweh Eloheynu commanded us; and we came to Qadesh-Barnea *6947*.

20. And I said to you, 'You have come to the mountain of the Emoriy, which Yahweh Eloheynu gives to us.

21. Look 7200, has set Yahweh Eloheycha 430 before us the land: go up and possess 3423 it, which says Yahweh Elohey 430 your forefathers to you, do not fear nor be discouraged 2865.'

22. And you came near to me all of you, and said, 'We will send 7971 men before us, and they will search out 2658 the land, and return 7725 to us word of the way 1870 that we go up 5927, and the cities that we go to.

23. And good in my eyes was the saying: and I took from you twelve men, one man from each tribe:

24. and they turned 6437 and went up into the mountain, and came unto the wadi 5158 of Esh'kol 812, and spied it out 7270.

25. And they took in their hands from the fruit *6529* of the land, and brought it down to us, and returned to us word, saying, 'Good is the land that Yahweh Eloheynu gives to us.'

26. But you would *14* not *3808* go up, but rebelled against *4784* the word *6310* of Yahweh Eloheychem *430*:

27. And you murmured 7279 in your tents, and said, 'Because hated 8135 Yahweh us, He brought us forth from the land of Mits'rayim 4714, to give us into the hand of the Emoriy, to destroy 8045 us.

28. Where 575 shall we go up? Our kinsmen have melted 4549 our heart 3824, saying, 'The people are greater 1419 and taller 7311 than us; the cities are great and fortified 1219 up to the sky; and also we the children of the Anaqiym 6062 we saw there.'

29. I said to you, 'Do not dread *6206*, neither fear *3372* from them.

30. Yahweh Eloheychem which goes before you, He shall fight *3898* for you, as all He did for you in Mits'rayim before your eyes;

31. and in the wilderness where you have seen how carried *5375* you Yahweh Eloheycha, as carries a man his son, in all the ways that you walked, until you came to this place.

32. In this matter you did not believe *539* Yahweh Eloheychem,

33. Who went before you in the way to search out *8446* for you a place to pitch your tents *2583*, in fire by night, to show the way that you should go, and in a cloud *6051* by day *3119*.

34. And heard Yahweh the voice of your words, and was angry 7107, and swore 7650, saying:

35. 'Surely not shall see any man of this generation *1755* of evil *7451* of this good land that I swore to give your forefathers,

36. except 2108 Kaleb 3612 son of Yephunneh 3312; he shall see, and him I will give the land that he has trodden 1869 upon, and to his children, because 3282 that he has fully 4390 followed after 310 Yahweh.'

37. Also with me was angry *599* Yahweh because of you *1558*, saying, 'Also you shall not go there.

38. Yahshua 3091 son of Nun 5126 who stands before you, he shall go there: strengthen 2388 him: for he shall cause to inherit it 5157 Yis'rael.

39. Your <u>little ones</u> 2945, that you said would be booty 957, and your children, that did not know in that day good 2896 and evil 7451, they shall go there, and to them I will give, and they shall possess 3423 it.

40. But you, turn *6437* you, and set out *5265* into the wilderness by the way of the Sea *3220* of Reeds *5488.*'

41. Then you answered *6030*, and said to me, 'We have sinned *2398* against Yahweh, we will go up and fight *3898*, according to all that commanded Yahweh Eloheynu.' And when girded on *2296* each man his instruments *3627* of war *4421*, you were ready *1951* to go up the hill.

42. Said Yahweh to me, 'Say to them, 'Do not go up, nor fight; because I am not 369 <u>among</u> you 7130; and be not smitten 5062 before your hated enemies 341.'

43. So I spoke to you; and you did not hear, but rebelled 4784 against the word 6310 of Yahweh, and presumptuously 2102 went up the mountain.

44. And came forth the Emority which dwelled on that mountain to meet 7215 you, and pursued 7291 you, as do bees 1688, and destroyed 3807 you in Seiyr 8165, unto Chor'mah 2767.

45. And you returned, and wept *1058* before Yahweh; but Yahweh did not hear your voice, nor give ear *238* to you.

46. So you dwelled in Qadesh 6946 many days, according to the days that you dwelled there.

Chapter 2

1. Then we turned *6437*, and set forth *5265* into the wilderness by the way of the Sea of Reeds, as had spoken Yahweh to me: and we went around *5437* the mountain of Seiyr many days.

2. And spoke Yahweh to me, saying:

3. 'Much 7227 have you gone around this mountain: turn you northward 6828,

4. and command the people, saying, 'You shall pass over the border *1366* of your kinsmen *251* the children of Esaw, who dwell in Seiyr; and they shall be in fear *3372* of you: <u>guard yourselves</u> *8104* greatly *3966*:

5. Do not 408 meddle 1624 with them; because I will not give you of their land, as much as treads 4096 the sole 3709 of a foot 7272, because as a possession 3425 to Esaw I have given the mountain of Seiyr.

6. Food 400 you shall buy 7666 from them with silver 3701, and also water you shall buy 3739 from them with silver, so you may drink 8354.

7. Because Yahweh Eloheycha has blessed you in all works of your hands: He knows your walkings *1980* in this great wilderness: these forty years Yahweh Eloheycha has been with you; you have not lacked *2637* anything.'

8. And when we passed from our kinsmen of the children of Esaw, who dwelled in Seiyr, through the way of the plain from Eylath *359*, and from Ets'yon-Gaber *6100*, we turned and passed through the way of the wilderness of Moab *4124*.

9. And said Yahweh to me, 'Do not be hostile 6696 to Moab, nor provoke 1624 them to battle 4421, for I will not give you of their land for a possession: for to the children of Lot 3876 I have given Ar 6144 for a possession.'

10. The Emiym *368* before you dwelled there, a people great *1419* and many *7227*, tall *7311*, as the Anaqiym *6092*.

11. Rephaiym 7497 they were accounted 2803 as, like 637 the Anaqiym; but the Moabiym 4125 call them Emiym.

12. And in Seiyr dwelt the Choriym 2572 before; but the children of Esaw dispossessed 3423 them, when they destroyed 8045 them from before them, and dwelt there instead 8478; as Yis'rael did to the land of his possession, which gave Yahweh to him.

13. And I said, 'Now rise up and go over the wadi Zared *2218*.' And we passed over the wadi Zared.

14. And the time that we walked from Qadesh-Bamea, until that we passed over the wadi Zared, was thirty eight years; until was consumed 8552 all the generation of the men of war from among the camp 4264, as swore Yahweh to them.

15. Also the hand of Yahweh was against them, to discomfit *2000* them from among the camp until they were consumed.

16. So it was, when were consumed all the men of war, and had died from among the camp,

17. that spoke Yahweh to me, saying:

18. 'You are to pass through this day the border 1366 of Moab at Ar 6144:

19. and when you come near 7126 in front of 4136 the children of Ammon 5983, do not 408 harass 6696 them, and do not meddle 1624 with them, as I have not 3808 given the land of the children of Ammon to you to possess 3425, for to the children of Lot 3876 I have given it to possess.'

20. The land to Rephaiym 7497 it was accounted 2803 also 637: Rephaiym dwelled there before; and the Ammoniym 5984 called them Zam'zummiym 2157,

21. a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anaqiym, destroyed *8045* Yahweh before them, and dispossessed them, and dwelled there the Ammoniym instead *8478*,

22. as He did for the children of Esaw, that dwelled in Seiyr, that He destroyed the Choriy *2752* before them, and dispossessed them, and they dwelled there instead until this day.

23. And the Awwiym 5757 that dwelled in Chatseriym 2699, unto Azzah 5804, the Kaph'toriym 3732 that came forth from Kaph'tor 3731, He destroyed, and they dwelled there instead.

24. 'Rise up! Set forth, and pass over the wadi Ar'non 769: see, I have given into your hand Siychon 5511, king of Chesh'bon 2809 of the Emoriy, and his land: begin 2490 to possess it, and provoke 1624 him to battle 4421.

25. This day I will begin to put the dread 6343 of you, and the fear 3374 of you upon the nations 5971 under the whole sky, that shall hear 8085 the report 8088 of you, and shall tremble 7264, and be in anguish 2342 from your presence.'

26. And I sent messengers from the wilderness of Qedemoth *6932* to Siychon king of Chesh'bon with words of peace, saying,

27. 'Let me pass through your land: I will go upon the highway, and I will not turn *5493* to the right *3225* or to the left *8040*.

28. Food for silver you shall sell *7666* me, so I may eat, and water for silver, you shall give me, so I may drink: I will only pass through upon my feet;

29. as did to me the children of Esaw that dwelled in Seiyr, and the Moabiym that dwelled in Ar, until that I have passed over the Yarden, to the land that Yahweh Eloheynu has given us.'

30. But Siychon king of Chesh'bon would not let us pass through: because hardened 7185 Yahweh Eloheycha his spirit, and made courageous 553 his heart, so that might give him into our hand that day

31. And said Yahweh to me, 'See, I have begun to give before you Siychon and his land: begin to possess it, so you may possess the land.'

32. Went forth Siychon to meet us in battle, he, and all his people, to do battle at Yah'tsah *3096*.

33. And gave him Yahweh Eloheynu before us, and we smote *5221* him, and his sons, and all his people.

34. And we captured 3920 all his cities at that time 6256, and we destroyed 2763 in all the cities the men 4962, and the women 802, and the little ones 2945, and did not leave 7604 survivors 8300.

35. Only the beasts 929 we took for booty 962, and the plunder 7998 of the cities we had captured.

36. From Aroer 6177 which is by the edge 8193 of the wadi Arnon, and the city that is by the wadi of Gilead 1568, there was not one city too high 7682 for us: and all gave Yahweh Eloheynu before us:

37. only to the land of the children of Ammon you did not come near, any place *3027* of the wadi Yabboq *2999*, or the cities in the hill country, or anything that commanded Yahweh Eloheynu.

Chapter 3

1. Then we turned 6437, and went up on the way to Bashan 1316, and came forth Og 5747 king of Bashan to meet us in battle, he, and all his people, to battle 4421 at Ed'reiy 154.

2. And said Yahweh to me, **Do not fear** 3372 him: because into your hand I give him with all his people, and his land; and you shall do that which you did to Siychon king of the Emoriy that dwelled in Chesh'bon.'

3. And gave Yahweh Eloheynu into our hand also Og king of Bashan and all his people: and we smote *5221* him until none *1115* were left *7604* and none *3808* surviving *8300*.

4. And we captured 3920 all his cities 5982 at that time, and there was no city 7151 that we did not take 3947 from them, sixty 8346 cities, all the district 2256 of Ar'gob 709, the kingdom 4467 of Og in Bashan.

5. All these cities were fortified *1219* with high *1364* walls *2346*, doors *1817*, and bars *1280*; beside cities un-walled *6521* of a great many.

6. And we utterly destroyed 2763 them, as we did to Siychon king of Chesh'bon, utterly destroying all in cities, men 4962, women 802, and children 2945.

7. But all the beasts 929, and the plunder 7998 of the cities, was booty 962 for us.

8. And we took at that time the land from the hand of two *8147* kings of the Emoriy that were on this side of the Yarden, from the wadi of Ar'non unto Mount Chermon *2768*:

9. The Tsidoniym 6722 called this Chermon Sir'yon 8303; and the Emoriy called it Seniyr 8149:

10. all cities of the plain *4334*, and all of Gilead, and all of Bashan, unto Sal'chah *5548* and Edreiy, cities of the kingdom of Og of Bashan.

11. For only Og king of Bashan remained 7604 of the remnant 349 of the Rephaiym 7497; behold, his bedstead 6210 was a bedstead of iron 1270; is it not in Rabath 7237 of the children of Ammon? Nine cubits 520 was the length 753 of it, and four cubits was the width 7341 of it, after the cubit of a man.

12. And this land, we possessed at this time, from Aroer 6177, that is by the wadi Ar'non, and half 2677 of Mount Gilead, and the cities of it I gave to the R'ubeniy 7206 and the Gadiy 1425.

13. And the rest of Gilead, and all Bashan, the kingdom of Og, I gave to the half-tribe of Menashsheh 4519: all the district of Ar'gob, with all Bashan, which was called the land of Rephaiym.

14. Yaiyr 2971 son of Menashsheh took all the district of Ar'gob unto the border of Geshuriy 1651 and Maachathiy 4602; and called them by his name, Bashan Chawwoth-Yair 2334 until this day.

15. And to Machiyr *4353* I gave Gilead.

16. And to the Rubeniy and the Gadiy I gave from Gilead unto the wadi Ar'non in the middle *8432* of the wadi of the border unto the wadi Yabboq *2999*, at the border of the children of Ammon,

17. and the plain *6160*, and the Yarden, to the border of Kinnereth *3672* to the sea of the plain,the Sea of Salt *4117*, beneath Ash'doth-haPis'gah *798* toward the sunrise *4217*.

18. And I commanded you at that time, saying, 'Yahweh Eloheychem has given you this land to possess it: you shall pass over armed for war 2502 before your kinsmen, the children of Yisrael, all sons *1121* of valor 2438.

19. But your wives, and your little ones, and your livestock, (for I know you have much livestock), shall abide in your cities which I have given you;

20. until that is given rest *5117* Yahweh to your kinsmen and yourself, and they possess also the land that Yahweh Eloheychem has given them on the other side of the Yarden: and shall return *7725* every man to his possession that I have given you.'

21. And Yahshua I commanded at this time, saying, 'Your eyes have seen all that did Yahweh Eloheychem to these two kings: so shall do Yahweh to all kingdoms that you pass through there.

22. You shall not fear them because Yahweh Eloheychem shall fight *3898* for you.

23. And I besought 2603 to Yahweh at that time, saying,

24. 'Lord *136* Yahweh *3069*, You have begun *2490* to show *7200* Your servant Your Magnificence *1433*, and Your Mighty *2389* Hand *3027*: for what *4310* el *410* in the sky *8064* or in the land *776* is there that can do according to Your Works *4639*, and according to Your Might *1369* ?

25. Please *4994*, let me go over, and see the good land that is beyond the Yarden, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon.'

26. But was angry 5674 Yahweh with me because of you, and would not hear me: and said

Yahweh to me, 'Let it suffice you 7227! Do not again 3254 speak to Me more 5750 of this matter 1697!

27. Go up to the top of Pisgah 6449, and lift up your eyes seaward 3220, and northward 6828, and southward 8486, and to the sunrise 4217, and look with your eyes: because you shall not go over this Yarden.

28. But command Yahshua, and encourage 2388 him, and strengthen 553 him: because he shall go over before this people, and he shall <u>cause them to inherit</u> 5157 the land which you shall see.'

29. So we abode in the valley *1516* in front *4136* of Beyth-Peor *1047*.

CHAPTER 3 NOTES

Yahweh instructed Yisrael to show no mercy, and to destroy and Rephayim found anywhere. Yahweh's patience was at an end with Mosheh, and basically said to him, "Too much!" when Mosheh asked to go over the Yarden. He and Aharon had not glorified Yahweh at Meriybah, and this was the punishment for it.

Chapter 4

1. Now 6258 Yis'rael, listen to the statutes 2706, and to the judgements 4941, which I teach 3925 to you, to do them, so that you may live, and go in and possess 3423 the land that Yahweh Elohey 430 your forefathers gives you.

2. You shall not add 3254 to the Word which I command 6680 you, neither diminish 1639 from it, so that you guard 8104 the commandments 4687 of Yahweh Eloheychem 430 that I command you.

3. Your eyes saw what did Yahweh over Baal-Peor *1187*: because all the men that walked *1980* after *310* Baal-Peor, has destroyed *8045* Yahweh Eloheycha from among *7130* you,

4. but you that clung *1695* to Yahweh Eloheychem are alive *2416*, all of you this day.

5. See 7200, I have taught you statutes and judgements, that commanded Yahweh Elohay 430, to do in the midst 7130 of the land that you go there to possess.

6. Therefore guard and do them, because this is your wisdom 2451 and understanding 998 in the eyes of the peoples, that shall hear of all these statutes, and say, 'Surely 7535 this people are wise 2450 and understanding 995, and this is a great nation 1419.'

7. Because what 4310 great nation is there that their elohiym 430 is so near 7138 to them as Yahweh Eloheynu 430, in all we <u>call upon</u> 7121 Him for?

8. And what nation so great, that has statutes and judgements so righteous *6662* as all this Torah *8451*, that I set before you this day?

9. Only guard you, and watch over yourselves greatly *3966*, lest you forget *7911* the things that have seen your eyes, and lest they depart *5493* from your mind *3824* all the days of your lives:

but make them known 3045 to your children, and your children's children;

10. the day that you stood before Yahweh Eloheycha in Choreb, when said Yahweh to me, 'Gather 6950 to Me the people, to hear My Words, so they may learn 3925 to revere 3372 Me all the days that they shall live upon the land, and may so teach 3925 their children.'

11. And you came near, and stood beneath the mountain; and the mountain burned *1197* with fire 784 unto the heart 3820 of the sky, with darkness 2822, clouds 6051, and thick darkness 6205.

12. And spoke Yahweh to you from the midst of the fire: the sound of His Words you heard, but no form *8544* did you see; only *2108* a voice.

13. And declared *5046* He to you His Covenant, that commanded He to you to do; and Ten *6235* Words wrote *3789* He upon two *8147* tablets *3871* of stone *68*.

14. And to to me commanded Yahweh at that time to teach you statutes 2706, and judgements 4941, to do them in the land that you go over there to possess.

15. Take heed *8104* greatly *3966* for yourselves *5315*, for you did not see a form on the day that spoke Yahweh to you in Choreb from the midst of the fire:

16. lest *6435* you become corrupt *7843*, and make yourselves an idol *6459*, the form of any statue *5566*, the image *8403* of male *2145* or female *5347*,

17. the image of any beast 929 that is on the land, the image of any bird 6833 with wings 3671 that flies 5774 in the sky 8064,

18. the image of anything that creeps 7430 upon the ground 127, the image of any fish 1710 that is in the waters beneath 8478 the land:

19. and lest you lift up your eyes to the sky, and when see you the sun 8121, and the moon 3394, and the stars 3556, and all the host 6635 of the sky 8064, that you are driven aside 5080 to bow down 7812 to them, and serve 5647 them, which Yahweh Eloheycha has apportioned 2505 to all people under the whole sky.

20. but you has taken Yahweh, and brought you forth from the furnace *3564* of iron *1270*, from Mits'rayim, to be to Him a people of inheritance *5159*, as this day.

21. And Yahweh was angry *599* with me over this matter, and swore *7650* that I should not *1115* cross over the Yar'den *3383*, and should not enter into the good land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you as an inheritance:

22. for I must die in this land, and not *369* cross over the Yar'den: but you shall cross over, and possess *3423* that good land.

23. Guard 8104 yourselves, lest 6435 you forget 7911 the Covenant 1285 of Yahweh Eloheychem, that He made 3772 with you, and make 6213 you a carved idol 6459, the form of anything, that has commanded Yahweh Eloheycha against.

24. Because Yahweh Eloheycha is a fire 784 that consumes 398, He 1931 is an El 410 of jealousy 7067.

25. For when you beget *3205* children, and children's children, and you have grown old *3462* in the land, and become corrupted *7843*, and make a carved idol, the form of anything, and do evil

7451 in the sight 5869 of Yahweh Eloheycha, to provoke Him to anger 3707:

26. I call as a witness 5749 against you this day the sky 8064 and the land 776, that you shall utterly perish 6/6 quickly 4118 from upon the land that you cross over the Yar'den there to possess; you shall not 3808 prolong 748 your days upon it, bu shall be utterly destroyed 8045/8045.

27. And shall scatter 6327 you Yahweh among the peoples 5971, and you shall be 7604 few 4962 in number 4557 among the nations 1471 where shall lead 5090 you Yahweh there 8033.

28. And you shall serve 5647 there elohiym 430, the work 4639 of the hands 3027 of adam 120, wood 6086 and stone 68, that do not see 7200, nor hear 8085, nor eat 398, nor smell 7306.

29. But if you seek *1245* from there Yahweh Eloheycha, you shall find *4672* Him, for if you seek *1875* Him with all your heart *3824* and all your being *5315*.

30. When you are in distress *6862*, and have found you all these things, in the end *319* of days, if you return *7725* unto Yahweh Eloheycha, and listen to His voice;

31. (for an El 410 of compassion 7349 is Yahweh Eloheycha): He will not forsake 7503 you, nor destroy 7843 you, nor forget 7911 the covenant of your forefathers which swore 7650 He to them.

32. For ask 7592 now 4994 of former 7223 days, that were before you, from the day that created 1254 Elohiym adam 120 upon the land, and from one end 7097 of the sky unto the other end of the sky, has there been any thing this great 1419, or have you heard 3644?

33. Have heard other people the voice of Elohiym speaking from the midst of the fire, as you have heard it, and lived?

34. Or has attempted 5254 Elohiym to come and take 3947 for Himself a nation from within another nation, by testing 4531, by signs 226, and by wonders 4159, and by war 4421, and by a mighty 2389 hand 3027 and a stretched out 2220 arm 5186, and by great terrors 4172, according to all that did for you Yahweh Eloheychem in Mits'rayim before your eyes?

35. You saw, so you would know that Yahweh, He is the Elohiym; and none 369 else 5750 beside 905 Him.

36. From the sky you heard His voice, that He might discipline *3256* you: and upon the land you saw His great fire; and His Words you heard from the midst of the fire.

37. Instead *8478* because He loved *157* your forefathers, chose *977* He their seedline *2233* after *310* them, and brought you forth with His Presence *6440*, and by His Great Might *3581*, from Mits'rayim;

38. to dispossess *3423* nations greater and mightier *6099* from before you, to bring you in, to give to you the land as an inheritance, as this day.

39. Know this day, return it to your heart, for Yahweh, He is the Elohiym of the sky above *4605*, and upon the land beneath: none else.

40. You shall guard *8104* His statutes *2706* and His commandments *4687*, that I command you this day, that it may go well *3190* with you, and your children after you, so that you may prolong *748* your days upon the land *127*, that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you for all your days.

41. Then set apart 914 Mosheh three cities on this side of the Yarden toward the rising 4217 of the sun 8121;

42. to flee 5127 there the manslayer 7523, that slays 7523 another person 7453 without 1097 knowledge 1847, and had not hated 8130 him in times past 8543/8032, and by fleeing to one of these cities he might live:

43. Betser *1221* in the wilderness, in the land of the plain *4334* of the R'ubeniy *7206*, and Ramoth *7216* in Gilead *1568*, of the Gadiy *1425*, and Golan *1474* in Bashan *1316*, of the Menashshiy *4520*.

44. This is the Torah *8451* that set *7760* Mosheh before the children of Yisrael:

45. these are the testimonies *5713*, and statutes *2706*, and judgements *4941*, which spoke Mosheh to the children of Yis'rael, after coming forth from Mits'rayim.

46. on this side of the Yar'den, in the valley *1516* in front of *4136* Beyth-Peor, in the land of Siychon king of the Emority that dwelled in Chesh'bon, which smote Mosheh and the children of Yis'rael, after coming forth from Mits'rayim.

47. And they possessed his land, and the land of Og king of Bashan, two kings of the Emoriy, that were on this side of the Yar'den toward the rising of the sun.

48. From Aroer 6177 that is upon the banks 8193 of the Wadi Arnon 769, unto Mount Siyon 7865, which is Chermon 2768,

49. and all the plain *6160* on this side of the Yarden toward the sunrise *4217*, unto the sea of the plain beneath Ash'doth-haPis'gah *798*.

Chapter 5

1. And called Mosheh to all Yisrael, saying to them: "Hear, Yisrael, the statutes and judgements which I speak in your ears today, that you may learn *3925* them, and guard *8104* and do *6213* them!

2. Yahweh Eloheynu made with us a Covenant in Choreb.

3. Not with our fathers did make Yahweh this Covenant, but with us 587, these here today that are all alive 2416.

4. Face 6440 to face spoke Yahweh with us in the mountain from the midst of the fire,

5. and I stood between Yahweh and you at that time, to declare *5046* to you the Word of Yahweh: because you were afraid *3372* of the presence of the fire, and did not go up the mountain: and He said,

[The Ten Words (Commandments)]

6. "I am Yahweh Eloheycha, which brought you forth from the land of Mits'rayim, from the House of Bondage *5650*:

7. You shall have no other 5921 elohiym 430 before 6440 Me.

8. You shall not make any carved idol 6459, of any form 8544 that is in the sky above, or that is on the land beneath, or that is in the waters beneath the land:

9. You shall not prostrate yourselves 7812 to them, nor serve 5647 them: because I 595, Yahweh Eloheycha am an El 410 of jealousy 7067, visiting 6485 punishment for the iniquity 5771 of the father upon the children unto the third 8029 and fourth 7256 generation of those who hate 8130 Me,

10. doing kindness 2617 to thousands 505 that love 157 Me, and keep 8104 My commandments 4687.

11. You shall not <u>take up</u> 5375 The Name of Yahweh Eloheycha in vain 7723: for Yahweh will not <u>leave unpunished</u> 5352 he that takes up His Name in vain.

12. Keep *8104* the Day *3117* of the Shabbath *7676* to observe as Holy *6942*, as commanded *6680* Yahweh Eloheycha.

13. Six 8337 days you shall labor 5647, and do all your work 4399:

14. But the seventh 7637 day is the Shabbath of Yahweh Eloheycha: you shall not do 6213

any 3605 work 4399, you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male slave 5650, nor your female slave 519, nor your ox 7994, nor your ass 2543, nor any of your beasts 929, nor any sojourner 1616 that is within your gates 8179; so that your male slaves and your female slaves may have rest 5117 as well as you.

15. And remember 2142 that you were a slave in the land of Mits'rayim, and brought you forth Yahweh Eloheycha from there with a mighty 2389 hand and stretched out 2220 arm 5186: for therefore has commanded Yahweh Eloheycha you to do 6213 the day of the Shabbath.

16. Honor 3513 your father 1 and your mother 517, as commanded you Yahweh Eloheycha; so that prolonged 748 are your days, and so that it might <u>be well</u> 3190 with you, upon the land 127 that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you.

[NOTE- In the Hebrew, verses 17-20 are all one verse]

17. [a] You shall not murder 7523.

[b] You shall not commit adultery 5003.

[c] You shall not steal 1589.

[d] You shall not answer 6030 falsely 7723 as a witness 5707 against another person 7453.

18. You shall not desire 2530 another person's wife 802, and you shall not desire 183 another person's house 1004, or his field 7704, or his male slave 5650, or his female slave 519, or his ox 7794, or his ass 2543, or anything 3605 that is another person's.'

19. These Words spoke Yahweh to all your assembly 6951 in the mountain from the midst of the fire, of the cloud 6051, and of the <u>dark clouds</u> 6205, with a great voice: He did not add more 3254. And He wrote 3789 them upon two 8147 tablets 3871 of stone 68, and gave them to me.

20. And it was, when you heard the voice from the midst of the darkness 2822, for the mountain burned *1197* with fire, that you came near to me, all the heads 7218 of your tribes 7626, and your elders 2205;

21. and you said, 'Behold, Yahweh Eloheynu has made us to see His Glory *3519* and His Magnificence *1433*, and we have heard His voice from the midst of the fire: we have seen this day that may speak Elohiym with an adam *120*, and he may remain alive *2425*.

22. And now, why should we die? Because this great fire will consume us: If again we hear the voice of Yahweh Eloheynu more. we shall die,

23. because who of all flesh *1320* that has heard the voice of the living Elohiym speaking from the midst of the fire as we *3644*, and lived?

24. Go near *7126* you *859*, and hear all that says Yahweh Eloheynu: and you speak to us all that speaks Yahweh Eloheynu to you; and we will hear, and do it.'

25. And heard Yahweh the sound *6963* of your words, when you spoke to me: and said Yahweh to me, 'I have heard the sound of the words of this people, that they spoke to you: they have <u>said well</u> *3190* all they have spoken.

26. O that there were such a mind 3824 in them, that they would revere 3372 Me, and keep

all My Commandments for all time, that it might <u>be well</u> 3190 with them, and with their children forever 5769!

27. Go and say to them, 'Return to your tents,'

28. but you, stand here with Me, and I will speak to you all the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgements which you shall teach 3925 them, so that they may do them in the land which I give them to possess.'

29. You shall guard *8104* and do *6213* that which commanded Yahweh Eloheychem to you: you shall not <u>turn aside</u> *5493* to the <u>right hand</u> *3225* or to the left *8040*.

30. In all the ways that commanded Yahweh Eloheychem to you, you shall walk, so that you live, and be well *2895* with you, and prolong *748* your days in the land which you shall possess."

Chapter 6

1. And these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgements, that commanded Yahweh Eloheychem to teach you, that you do them in the land that you go over there to possess:

2. so that you revere *3372* Yahweh Eloheycha, and guard all His statutes and judgements, that I command you, your children, and your children's children, all the days of your lives; that prolonged are your days.

3. Hear, Yisrael, and guard and do; that it be well with you, and that you may increase 7235 greatly 3966, as that which spoke Yahweh Elohey of your forefathers to you, of the land that flows 2100 with milk 2461 and honey 1706.

4. Hear, Yisrael! Yahweh Eloheynu, Yahweh is One!

[Sh'ma, Yis'rael! YHWH Eloheynu, YHWH Echad!]

5. And you shall love *157* Yahweh Eloheycha with all your heart *3824*, and all your being *5315*, and all your might *3966*.

6. And shall be these Words that I command you this day upon your heart:

7. and you shall teach them incisively 8150 to your children, and shall speak of them when you sit 3427 in your house, and when you walk 1980 in the way 1870, and when you lie down 7901, and when you arise 6965.

8. And you shall bind 7194 them as a sign 226 upon your hand 3027, and they shall be 1961 as frontlet bands 2903 between 996 your eyes 5869,

9. and you shall write *3789* them upon the doorposts *4201* of your house, and upon your gates *8179*.

10. [a] And it shall be when brings 935 you Yahweh Eloheycha into the land that He swore 7650 to your forefathers, to Ab'raham 85, [b] to Yits'chaq 3327, [c] and to Yaaqob 3290, to give you cities 5892 great 1419 and good 2896, that you did not build 1129,

11. and houses filled 4392 with all goodness 2896, that you did not fill 4390, and cisterns 953 dug 2672, that you did not dig, vineyards 3754, and olive trees 2132 that you did not plant 5193, when you have eaten, and become satisfied 7646;

12. take heed 8104 lest 6435 you forget 7911 Yahweh, which brought you forth from the land of Mits'rayim, from the house of bondage 5650.

13. Yahweh Eloheycha revere 3372, and serve 5647 you, and by His Name swear 7650.

14. You shall not walk 1980 after 310 other 312 elohiym of the elohey of the people that are around 5439 you,

15. because an El 410 of jealousy 7067 is Yahweh Eloheycha among 7130 you, lest 6435 be kindled 2734 the anger 639 of Yahweh Eloheycha against you, and He exterminates 8045 you from upon the surface of the land 127.

16. [a] Do not test 5254 Yahweh Eloheychem, [b] as you tested in Massah 4532.

17. You shall diligently keep *8104/8104* the commandments of Yahweh Eloheychem, and His Testimonies *5713*, and statutes *2706*, that He commanded.

18. And you shall do what is upright 3477 and good 2896 in the eyes of Yahweh: so that it is well with you, to go to possess the good land that swore Yahweh to your forefathers,

19. to drive out 1920 all the hated enemies before you, as spoke Yahweh.

20. Because when ask 7592 your children in the future 4279, saying, 'What means the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgements, that commanded Yahweh Eloheynu to you?'

21. Then you shall say to your children, 'We were slaves of Par'oh in Mits'rayim; and Yahweh brought us out of Mits'rayim with a mighty hand:

22. and gave Yahweh signs 226 and wonders 4159, great and harmful 7451 on Mits'rayim, on Paroh, and on all his household in our sight 5869:

23. and us He brought forth from there, so that He might bring us, and give to us the land that He swore to our forefathers.

24. And commanded us Yahweh to do all these statutes, and to revere *3372* Yahweh Eloheynu, for our good at all times *3117*, and we might live as this day *3117*.

25. It shall be righteousness *6666* to us, if *3588* we guard and do all these commandments before Yahweh Eloheynu that He commanded us.'

Chapter 6 Notes

In verse 8, the term frontlet bands 2903 is used. The Hebrew is totaphoth, and is used in a metaphorical sense. Bind on the hand means your actions, and between the eyes means your thoughts. They were never meant to be physical items to be tied on. In verse 25, the little word if is the key to the verse. Yisrael did not obey, and dabbled with foreign "gods", eventually resulting in the captivities, and finally the dispersion among the nations. These rules are emphasized again in Chapter 7.

Chapter 7

1. When brings you Yahweh Eloheycha into the land that you go there to possess, and has removed *5394* many nations from before you, the Chittiy *2850*, and the Gir'gashiy *622*, and the Emoriy *567*, and the Kenaaniy *3669*, and the Perizziy *6522*, and the Chiwwiy *2340*, and the Yebusiy *2983*: seven nations greater *7227* and mightier *6099* than you;

2. and gives them Yahweh Eloheycha before you, you shall smite *5221* them, and <u>utterly destroy</u> *2763/2763* them; and shall not make *3772* with them a covenant *1285*, nor show mercy *2603*:

3. nor make marriages 2859 with them; your daughters you shall not give to their sons, nor their daughters take for your sons.

4. Because they will turn away 5493 your sons from following 310 Me, to serve 5647 other 312 elohiym: so will kindle 2734 the anger 639 of Yahweh against you, and destroy 8045 you quickly.

5. Therefore this you will do with them: their altars *4196* you will destroy *5422*, and their <u>sacred</u> <u>pillars</u> *4676* you will <u>break down</u> *7665*, and their <u>Ashera poles</u> *842* you shall <u>cut down</u> *1438*, and their <u>carved idols</u> *6456* you shall burn with fire.

6. Because you are a Holy 6918 people to Yahweh Eloheycha: you has chosen 977 Yahweh Eloheycha to be to Him a treasured 5459 people, over all the people that are upon the surface 6440 of the soil 127.

7. Not because you were <u>more in number</u> 7230 than all the people did Yahweh set His love 2836 upon you to choose 977 you, because you were the fewest 4592 of all the people:

8. but because Yahweh loved *160* you, and would keep *8104* the oath *7621* that He swore *7650* to your forefathers, has brought you forth Yahweh with a mighty *2389* hand, and redeemed *6299* you from the House of Bondage *5650*, from the hand of Par'oh *6547* king of Mits'rayim.

9. Know therefore, because Yahweh Eloheycha, He is the Elohiym 430, The El 410 of Faithfulness 539, which keeps 8104 the Covenant 1285, with mercy 2617 to those who love 157 Him, and keep His commandments 4687, to a thousand 505 generations 1755;

10. and repays 7999 those that hate 8130 Him to their face 6440, to destroy 6 them: He will not 3808 <u>hold back</u> 309 from those who hate Him; to their face He shall repay them.

11. You shall keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgements that I command you this day, and do them.

12. It shall be, at the last *6118*, if you hear *8085* these judgements, and keep and do them, shall keep Yahweh Eloheycha with you the Covenant and the Mercy that He swore *7650* to your forefathers:

13. And He will love 157 you, and bless 1288 you, and multiply 7235 you: He will bless the fruit 6259 of your womb 990, and the fruit of your soil 127, your corn 1715, and your <u>new wine 8492</u>, and your <u>fresh oil</u> 3323, the increase 7698 of your cattle 504, and the flocks 6251 of your sheep 6629, upon the soil 127 that He swore 7650 to your forefathers to give you.

14. Blessed you shall be of all the peoples: there shall not be <u>barren males</u> 6135 or <u>barren</u> <u>females</u> 6135 among you, or among your beasts 929.

15. And shall take away 5493 Yahweh from among you all sickness 2483, and all the diseases 4064 of Mits'rayim that are harmful 7451, that you have knowledge of, He shall not put 7760 upon you, but put 5414 upon those who hate you 8130.

16. And you shall consume 398 all the people that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you; no pity 2347 of your eye 5869 shall be upon them: neither shall you serve 5647 eloheyhem 430; because that will be a snare 4170 to you.

17. Because if you say in your heart, 'More numerous 7227 are these nations than us. How 349

are we able 3201 to dispossess 3423?'

18. Do not fear *3372* from them: remember well *2142/2142* what did Yahweh Eloheycha *430* to Par'oh *6547* and all Mits'rayim.

19. The great *1419* testing *4531* that you saw with your eyes, and the signs *226*, and the wonders *4159*, and the mighty hand, and the stretched out arm, that brought you forth, of Yahweh Eloheycha, so shall do Yahweh Eloheycha to all the people that you fear the presence of.

20. Also the hornet *6880* shall send Yahweh Eloheycha among them, until are destroyed *6* those left *7604* that hide themselves *5641* from your presence.

21. You shall not be frightened 6206 from their presence: for Yahweh Eloheycha is <u>among you</u> 7130, an El 410 Great 1419 and Awesome 3372.

22. And will remove *5394* Yahweh Eloheycha those nations from before you little *4592* by little: you may not be able to <u>put an end</u> *3615* to them quickly *4118*, lest increase *7235* upon you the living creatures *2416* of the field *7704*.

23. But shall give *5414* Yahweh Eloheycha them before you, and shall confuse *1949* them with a great discomfiture *4103* until they are destroyed *8045*.

24. And He shall give their kings into your hand, and shall perish 6 their names from under the sky: there shall not be able to stand *3320* a man before you until you have destroyed them.

25. Their carved idols 6456 of eloheyhem you shall burn in the fire: you shall not desire 2530 the silver or the gold upon them, nor take it to you, lest you be snared 3369 in it: because it is an abomination 8441 to Yahweh Eloheycha.

26. Neither shall you bring an abomination into your house, or you will become a <u>cursed thing</u> 2764 like it 3644, you shall utterly detest 8262/8262 it, and you shall utterly abhor 8581/8581 it; because it is a cursed thing.

Chapter 7 Notes

7:1 lists the nations to be destroyed, and 7:2 says no mercy. 7:3 says no marriages with other races, and 7:4 gives the reason. There is nothing unclear here at all, so why are we mixing? Why are we allowing racially alien "gods" (Allah, Buddha, Krishna, Odin, etc.) among us? This is the result of apostasy in the so-called "christian churches" today. They teach and live contrary to Yahweh's Torah, and say it has been "nailed to the cross". These are lies of the Devil, and they willingly do his works. Yahweh's Torah has not changed, nor passed away, nor has the true Shabbath Day changed, but these synagogues of Satan are teaching these things. Come out of them, My people, and be you separate!

2. And you shall remember 2142 all the way 1870 that made you to walk 1980 Yahweh Eloheycha these forty 705 years in the wilderness, so that you are humbled 6031, and to prove 5254 you, to know what is in your heart 3824, to observe His commandments or not.

3. And He humbled you, and allowed you to hunger 7456, and made you to eat man 4478, that you knew not, nor knew your fathers; so that you might know that not upon bread 3899 alone 905 lives adam 120, but upon all that proceeds 4161 from the mouth of Yahweh lives adam.

4. Your clothing *8071* did not grow old *1086* upon you, and your feet *7272* did not swell *1216*, these forty years.

5. You shall know in your mind *3824*, for that as chastens *3256* a man *376* his children, Yahweh Eloheycha chastens you.

6. You shall observe the commandments of Yahweh Eloheycha, to walk in His ways, and revere *3372* Him,

7. because Yahweh Eloheycha brings you into a land that is good, a land of brooks 5158 of water, of fountains 5869 of deepness 8415 that go forth from valley plains 1237 and hills 2022,

8. a land of wheat 2406, and barley 8184, and vines 1612, and fig trees 8384, and pomegranates 7416; a land of olive trees 2132 and olive oil 8081 and honey 1706;

9. a land that without scarceness 4544 you shall eat bread, you shall not lack 2637 anything there: a land that the stones are iron 1270, and from the hills you may dig 2672 copper 5178.

10. When you have eaten and are full *7646*, then you shall bless *1288* Yahweh Eloheycha for the good land that He has given you.

11. Guard *8104* yourselves lest you forget *7911* Yahweh Eloheycha, by not guarding His commandments, judgements, and statutes, that I command you today,

12. lest you eat and become full 7646, and good houses you build, and dwell in them,

13. and when your herds and flocks multiply, and your silver and gold multiply, and all that you have is multiplied,

14. then you are lifted up 7311 in your mind 3824, and you forget Yahweh Eloheycha, which brought you forth from the land of Mits'rayim from the house of bondage;

15. Who made you to walk through the wilderness, great and awesome, poisonous *8314* serpents *5175*, scorpions *6137*, and drought *6774*, that had no water: Who brought forth water from the rock *6697* of flint *2496*,

16. Who had you eat man 4478 in the wilderness, that did not know your fathers, so that you might be humbled, so that you might be proved, to do you good 3190 at the latter end 319,

17. and you might say in your mind, 'My power 3581, and the might 6108 of my hand has caused 6213 this wealth 2428.'

18. But you shall remember Yahweh Eloheycha: because He gives to you the power to have wealth, so that He may establish *6965* His Covenant that He swore to your forefathers this day.

19. And it shall be, if you forget at all 7911/7911 Yahweh Eloheycha, and walk after other elohiym and serve them, and prostrate before them, I stand witness 5749 to you today that you will surely perish 6/6.

20. as the nations that Yahweh destroyed *6* before you, so shall you perish; because you would *6118* not listen to the Voice of Yahweh Eloheycha.

CHAPTER 8 NOTES

Chapter 8 is a warning against Yisrael getting "fat and happy" in the new land they were about to possess, and then going into apostasy with pagan idol worship, and borrowed local traditions which they did later on. The Talmud ("Studies" as it means in Hebrew), is from Babel (Babylon), and contradicts Scripture many times. Yahshua Messiah castigated the false priests and Pharisees for following "the traditions of men", which are all the added-on rabbinical "laws" that the Talmudists still use today. This warning is still applicable today, as the so-called "Christian churches " are teaching apostasy, and observing pagan rites as "holidays" such as "Christmas" [Yule], "Easter" [spring solstice as Ishtar Sunday, for the fertility "goddess"], and Sunday worship. The Shabbath day varies according to the Romish calendar, but by the true Solar calendar is is a constant, and no Scriptural authority for men to change it can be found. All of this is PAGAN, and true worshippers of Yahweh will not follow them. "Church doctrine" may NOT override Scripture. Come out from among them My people, and be you separate!

Chapter 9

1. Hear, O Yis'rael: You are to pass over this day the Yarden, to go in and dispossess *3423* nations greater *1419* and mightier *6090* than yourselves, cities great and fortified *1219* to the sky.

2. A people great and tall *7311*, children of the Anaqiym *6062*, whom you know, and of whom you have heard said, 'Who can stand before the children of Anaq *6061*?'

3. Know this day because Yahweh Eloheycha is He that goes over before you; as a fire that consumes He shall destroy 8045 them, and He shall subdue 3665 them before you: you shall dispossess them , and destroy 6 them quickly 4118, as that which said Yahweh to you.

4. Do not say in your mind *3824*, after Yahweh Eloheycha has driven them out *1920* from before you, saying, 'For my righteousness *6666* has brought me Yahweh to possess this land': but it is for the wickedness *7564* of these nations that Yahweh dispossesses them before you.

5. Not for righteousness, or uprightness *3476* of your heart, you go to possess the land: but for the wickedness of these nations Yahweh Eloheycha dispossesses them from before you, so that He may perform *6965* the Word that swore Yahweh to your forefathers, Ab'raham, Yits'chaq, and Yaaqob.

6. Know, because not for righteousness does Yahweh Eloheycha give you this good land to possess; for a people of hard 7186 necks 6203 are you.

7. Remember 2142, and do not forget 7911, how you <u>provoked to anger</u> 7107 Yahweh Eloheycha in the wilderness, from the day that you went forth from the land of Mits'rayim until came you to this place, you have been rebellious 4784 against Yahweh.

8. Also in Choreb 2722 you provoked to wrath Yahweh, so was angry 599 enough Yahweh against you to destroy 8045 you.

9. When I ascended *5927* the mountain to receive *3947* the tablets of stone, the tablets of the Covenant that made Yahweh with you, then I abode *3427* upon the mountain forty days and forty nights, and bread I did not eat, and water I did not drink:

10. and gave Yahweh to me the two tablets of stone, written *3789* by the finger *676* of Elohiym upon them all the Words that spoke Yahweh with you in the mountain from the midst of of the fire in the day of the assembly *6951*.

11. And it was at the end *7093* of forty days and forty nights, that gave Yahweh to me the two tablets of stone, the tablets of the Covenant.

12. Said Yahweh to me, "Arise 6965, get you down quickly 4118 from there; because have corrupted themselves 7843 the people that you brought forth from Mits'rayim, and have turned aside 5493 quickly 4118 from the way that I commanded them; and made 6213 themselves a cast image 4541."

13. Said Yahweh to me, saying, "I have seen these people, and behold, a people *5186* of hard necks are they:

14. withdraw 7503 from Me, so I may destroy 8045 them, and <u>wipe out</u> 4229 their name from under the sky: and make you a nation mightier and greater than they."

15. So I turned *6437* and came down from the mountain, and the mountain burned *1197* with fire: and the two tablets of the Covenant were in my two hands.

16. I looked, and behold, you had sinned 2398 against Yahweh Eloheychem, and had made you a cast 4541 calf 5695: you had turned aside 5493 quickly 4118 from the way that had commanded Yahweh to you.

17. I seized *8610* the two tablets, and <u>cast them</u> *7993* from my two hands, and broke *7665* them before your eyes,

18. and I <u>fell down</u> 5307 before Yahweh, as at the first 7223, forty days and forty nights: bread I did not eat, and water I did not drink, over all your sins 2400 that you sinned 2403, in doing evil 7451 in the sight of Yahweh, to provoke Him to anger 3707.

19. For I was afraid 3025 from the presence of the anger 639 and displeasure 2534 by with was wroth 7107 Yahweh against you to destroy 8045 you. But listened 8085 Yahweh to me at that time.

20. Against Aharon was enraged *599* Yahweh enough to destroy *8045* him, and I prayed *6419* also for Aharon at that time.

21. And the sin 2403 that you had made, the calf, I took, and burned 8313 it with fire, and crushed 3807 it, and ground 2912 it fully 3190, until it was beaten 1854 into dust 6083, and I

cast 7993 the dust into the brook 5158 that came down from the mountain.

22. And at Taberah *8404* [a], and at Massah *4532* [b], and Qib'roth-haTaawah *6914* [c], you did provoke to wrath Yahweh.

23. When sent you Yahweh from Qaddesh-Bar'nea 6947, saying, "Go up and possess the land that I have given you,": then you rebelled 4784 against the Words 6310 of Yahweh Eloheychem, and did not believe 539 Him, nor listen to His voice.

24. You have been rebellious against Yahweh from the day that I knew you.

25. So I fell down before Yahweh forty days and forty nights, as I fell down at the first; because had said Yahweh He would destroy you.

26. I prayed *6419* to Yahweh, and said, 'Lord *136* Yahweh, do not *408* destroy Your people and Your inheritance *5159*, that You redeemed *6299* by Your Magnificence *1433*, which You brought forth from Mits'rayim with a Mighty Hand.

27. Remember Your servants, Abraham, Yitschaq, and Yaaqob; look not to the stubbornness *7190* of this people, to their wickedness *7562*, or to their sin *2403* :

28. lest say the land that they came forth from, 'Was not 1047 able 3201 Yahweh to bring them into the land that He spoke of to them, and because He hated 8135 them He brought them forth to <u>put them to death</u> 4191 in the wilderness.'

29. They are Your people and Your inheritance that You brought forth by Your great *1419* power *3581* and by Your <u>stretched out</u> *5186* arm.

CHAPTER 9 NOTES

Again Mosheh rebukes and reminds Yisrael of their past rebellions. He reminds them clearly that only the Grace of Yahweh is why they were chosen, not their own attributes. He reminds them of his own efforts to keep them from Yahweh's destruction. This a very passionate and moving account. It continues in Chapter 10.

Chapter 10

1. At that time said Yahweh to me, "Carve 6458 you two tablets of stone, like the first, and come up to Me in the mountain, and make you an ark 727 of wood.

2. And I will write *3789* upon the tablets the Words that were upon the first tablets that you broke *7665*, and you shall put them in the ark."

3. And I made an ark of the wood of Shittiym *7848*, and carved two tablets of stone like the first, and went up the mountain, with the two tablets in my hands.

4. And He wrote upon the tablets, as the writing upon the first, the Ten Words, which spoke Yahweh to you in the mountain from the midst of the fire in the day of the assembly: and gave Yahweh them to me.

5. And I <u>turned myself</u> 6437 and came down from the mountain, and put the tablets in the Ark which I had made; and they are there as that which commanded Yahweh.

6. And the children of Yisrael <u>set forth</u> 5265 from B'eroth-B'ney-Yaaqan 885 to Mosera 4149: and there died Aharon, and was buried there; and <u>ministered in the priest's office</u> 3547 El'azar 499 his son in his stead 8478.

7. From there they set forth to Gud'godah 1412; and from Gud'godah to Yot'bathah 3193, a land of streams 5158 of waters 4325.

8. At that time set apart *914* Yahweh the tribe *7626* of Lewiy *3878* to carry *5375* the Ark of the Covenant of Yahweh, to stand *5975* before Yahweh to minister *8334* to Him, and to bless *1288* in His Name *8034* unto this day.

9. Wherefore it shall not be for the Lewiy to have a portion 2506 or inheritance 5159 with their kinsmen 251; Yahweh, He is their inheritance, as that which spoke Yahweh Eloheycha.

10. And I stood upon the mountain as the first days, forty days and forty nights; and listened Yahweh to me also at that time, and would *14* not *3808* Yahweh destroy you *7843*.

11. And said Yahweh to me, "Arise 6965, walk 1980 to your station 4550 before the people, so they may go in and possess the land that I swore to their forefathers to give them."

12. And now, Yis'rael, what does Yahweh Eloheycha require 7592 of you, but to revere 3372 Yahweh Eloheycha, and walk in all His ways, and to love 157 Him, and serve 5647 Yahweh Eloheycha with all your heart and all your being 5315,

13. to observe *8104* the commandments *4687* of Yahweh, and the statutes *2708* that I command this day for your good *2896*?

14. Behold, of Yahweh Eloheycha is the sky 8064, and the sky of skies, and the land, and all that is in it!

15. Only *7535* upon your forefathers delighted *2836* Yahweh to love *157* them, and He chose *977* their seedline *2233* after them, you of all peoples, as this day.

16. Circumcise 4135 the foreskins 6190 of your hearts 3824, and your neck 6203 be not stiff 7185 any more 5750.

17. Because Yahweh Eloheycha, He *1931* is Elohey *430* of Elohiym *430*, and Lord *113* of lords *113*, the Great El *410*, mighty *1368* and awesome *3372*, that does not lift up *5375* faces *6440*, nor take *3947* bribes *7810*,

18. but makes *6213* justice *4941* for the fatherless children *3490* and widows *490*, and loves *157* the sojourner 1616, giving food *3899* and clothing *8071*.

19. Therefore love the sojourner, because sojourners you were in the land of Mits'rayim.

20. Yahweh Eloheycha you shall hold in awe *3372*; and you shall serve Him, and cleave *1692* to Him, and by His Name you shall swear *7650*.

21. He is your praise 8416, and He is Eloheycha, that has done for you these great and awesome things, that saw you with your eyes.

22. With seventy 7657 people went down your forefathers to Mits'ray'mah 4714, and now has made you 7760 Yahweh Eloheycha as the stars 3556 of the skies 8064 in multitude 7230.

CHAPTER 10 NOTES

Chapter 10 is a further accounting of prior occurrences, along with additional exhortations for righteousness. Verse **16** speaks of circumcision of the heart (or mind), and the entire being *5315*. What this means is "total commitment" to Yahweh. The heart *3824* in Hebrew is the center of thought, not emotion, as in the Greek. Your thoughts and actions are to be centered on Yahweh's Torah.

Chapter 11

1. You shall love *157* Yahweh Eloheycha, and guard *8104* the observance *4931* of His statutes *2708*, and judgements *4941*, and commandments *4637* for all the days *3117*.

2. And know this day: because I speak not to your children that do not know, that have not seen the chastisement *4148* of Yahweh Eloheychem - His magnificence *1433*, His mighty hand, and stretched out arm,

3. and the signs 226 and wonders 4639 that He did in the midst of Mits'rayim to Par'oh 6547 the king of Mits'rayim and all his land;

4. and what He did to the army 2428 of Mits'rayim, and their horses 5483, and their chariots 7893; that He made to overflow 6687 the waters of the Sea 3220 of Reeds 5488 over the presence of those that pursued 7291 after 310 you, and destroyed 6 them Yahweh until this day;

5. and what He did to you in the wilderness until you came unto this place;

6. and what He did to Dathan and Abiyram, sons of Eliyab, son of R'uben: that opened 6475 the ground 776 its mouth 6310, and <u>swallowed them up</u> 1104, and their households, and their tents, and all the possessions 3351 at their feet 7272, in the midst 7130 of all Yis'rael -

7. but your eyes have seen all the great works of Yahweh that He did.

8. So you shall guard all the commandments that I command you this day, so that you will be strong *2388*, and go in and possess the land, that you pass over to possess,

9. so that you may prolong 748 your days upon the soil 127 that swore Yahweh to your forefathers to give to them, and their seedline 2233, land flowing 2100 with milk 2461 and honey 1706.

10. Because the land where you go to possess is not as the land of Mits'rayim, that which you came out from, there where you sowed seed and watered it with your feet, as a garden 1588 of herbs 3419:

11. and the land that you cross over there to possess, is a land of hills and valley plains, and from the sky it drinks water.

12. A land that Yahweh Eloheycha <u>cares for</u> *1875*, and continually *8548* the eyes of Yahweh Eloheycha are upon it, from the first *7225* of the year until the end *319* of the year.

13. And it shall be, if you <u>listen faithfully</u> 8085/8085 to the commandments that I command you this day, to love Yahweh Eloheychem, and to serve Him with all your heart, and all your being,

14. He will give the rain 4306 for the land in its time 6256, the early rain 3138 and the <u>latter rain</u> 4456, so you may gather 622 your corn 1715, and your <u>new wine</u> 8492, and your <u>fresh oil</u> 3323.

15. And He will give grass *6212* to your fields *7704* for your beasts *929*, that they may eat and be satisfied *7646*.

16. Guard 8104 yourselves, lest <u>be deceived</u> 6601 your mind 3824, and you <u>turn aside</u> 5493 to serve 5647 other 312 elohiym 430, and prostrate yourselves 7812 to them,

17. and kindle 2734 the anger 639 of Yahweh against you, and He shuts up 6113 the sky, and there be no rain, and the soil 127 gives no crops 2981; and you perish 6 quickly 4120 from upon the good 2896 land 776 that Yahweh gives you.

18. You shall place these Words upon your mind and upon your <u>inner being</u> 5315, and bind 7194 them for a sign 226 upon your hand 3027, so they may be as <u>frontlet bands</u> 2903 between 996 your eyes,

19. and you shall teach *3925* them to your children, speaking of them when you sit *3427* in your house, and walk *1980* in the way *1870*, and when you <u>lie down</u> *7901*, and when you <u>rise up</u> *6965*,

20. and you shall write *3789* them upon the doorposts *4201* of your house, and upon your gates *8179*:

21. so that are multiplied 7235 your days, and the days of your children, upon the soil 127 that swore Yahweh to your forefathers to give them, as the days of the sky upon the land 776.

22. because if you <u>diligently keep</u> 8104/8104 all these commandments that I command you, to do them, to love Yahweh Eloheychem, and walk in His ways, and cleave to Him,

23. then will dispossess *3423* Yahweh all these nations *1471* before you, and you shall dispossess nations greater and more numerous than yourselves.

24. All places 4725 where tread 1869 the soles 3709 of your feet 7272 shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river 5104, the river Perath 6578, unto the sea 3220 of the west 314, shall be your borders 1366.

25. No man shall be able to stand before you: the fear *6343* and dread *4172* of you shall put Yahweh Eloheychem upon the face of all the land that you tread upon, as that He said to you.

26. See 7200, I put before you this day a blessing 1293, and a curse 7045;

27. A blessing, if *834* you listen *8085* to the the commandments *4687* of Yahweh Eloheychem, that I command *6680* you this day:

28. or a curse, if 518 you do not listen to the commandments of Yahweh Eloheychem, but <u>turn</u> aside 5493 from the way that I command you this day, to walk 1980 after 310 other 312 elohiym 430, that you have not known 3045.

29. And it shall be, when Yahweh Eloheycha has brought you into the land that you have come there to possess, that you shall put the blessing upon Mount Geriziym *1630*, and the curse upon Mount Eybal *5858*.

30. Are they not on the other side of the Yarden, after the way that <u>goes down</u> 3996 the sun 8121, in the land of the Kenaaniy, which dwell in the plains 6160 in front of 4136 Gil'gal 1537, besides 681 the plains 436 of Moreh 4176?

31. Because you pass over the Yarden to go to possess the land that Yahweh Eloheychem gives you, and possess it, and dwell in it.

32. And you shall observe and do all the statutes and the judgements that I set before you this day.

CHAPTER 11 NOTES

This chapter is more historical reminders, and exhortation against fear of entering into the new land. Verse **18**, however, has been misused by the Talmudists, and instead of a metaphorical passage, they have turned it into a literal one. It was never intended by Mosheh to literally bind little boxes of Scripture upon your arm and forehead. You are to do these commandments with your hands, and keep them upon your mind. Verses **19** and **20** back this up, showing the action to be taken in discussing them publicly, teaching them to your children, and posting them on your doorposts and gates for all to see. This shows the non-Yisraelites who you are, and which Elohiym is YOURS. The big if appears again in verses **13** and **27**. All these blessings were contingent upon OBEDIENCE to Yahweh. This does not mean obedience to later added rabbinical commands of the Talmudists.

Brown-Driver-Briggs Gesenius Hebrew-English Lexicon confirms 2903 frontlet bands, as a metaphorical usage, and says "tephillin" - (boxes of Scripture, tied on) were a post-Babylonian captivity creation of Talmudic "rabbis".

Chapter 12

1. These are the statutes and judgements, that you shall observe and do in the land that gives you Yahweh, Elohey 430 of your forefathers for a possession, for all the days that you live upon the soil 127.

2. You shall <u>utterly destroy</u> 6/6 all the places that serve there the nations that you will dispossess their eloheyhem, upon the high 7311 mountains 2022, and upon hills 1389, and under 8478 all luxuriant 7488 tree 6086:

3. and you shall <u>tear down</u> 5422 their altars, and break 7665 their <u>sacred pillars</u> 4676, and their ashereyhem 842 you shall burn with fire; and their <u>carved idols</u> 6456 of eloheyhem you shall <u>hew down</u> 1438, and destroy 6 their names from that place.

4. You shall not do 6213 in this manner 3651 to Yahweh Eloheychem,

5. but to the place that chooses 977 Yahweh Eloheychem from all your tribes to put His Name there, His Habitation 7933 you shall seek 1875, and shall come there.

6. And you shall bring there your burnt offerings, and your slaughterings of sacrifice, and your tithes *4643*, and heave offerings of your hand, and your vows, and your gift offerings, and the firstborn of your herds and your flocks:

7. and there you shall eat before Yahweh Eloheychem, and you shall rejoice in all you put your hand to, you, and your households, in which Yahweh Eloheycha has blessed you.

8. You shall not not do all we do here today, doing any man all that is upright 3477 in his own eyes,

9. for we have not come unto at this time, to the rest *4496* and to the inheritance that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you.

10. When you cross over the Yar'den, and dwell in the land that Yahweh Eloheychem gave you to inherit 5157, when He gives you rest 5117 from all your hated enemies all around, so you dwell in safety 983;

11. there shall be a place that chooses Yahweh Eloheychem to cause to dwell His Name there; and there you shall bring all that I command you, your burnt offerings, your slaughterings of sacrifice, your tithes, and the heave offering of your hand, and all your choice 4005 vows 5088 that you vow 5087 to Yahweh.

12. and you shall rejoice *8055* before Yahweh Eloheychem, you, and your sons and your daughters, and your male slaves, and your female slaves, and the Lewiy that is within your gates; because they have no portion or inheritance with you.

13. Guard *8104* yourself, lest you send up your burnt offerings in any place that you see:

14. but only in the place that shall choose Yahweh in one of your tribes, there you shall send up your burnt offerings, and there you shall do all that I command you.

15. Whatever 7535/3605 desires 185 your being 5315, you may slaughter 2076 and eat flesh, with the blessing 1293 of Yahweh Eloheycha that He gives to you, within all your gates 8179: those unclean 2931 and those clean 2889 may eat of it, as of the gazelle 6643, and the deer 354.

16. Only 7535 the blood 1818 you shall not eat; upon the ground you shall pour 8210 it, as water.

17. You may not eat within your gates the tithe 4643 of your corn 1715, or <u>new wine</u> 8492, or your oil 3323, or of the firstborn 1062 of your herds and flocks, or of any vows 5087 that you vow 5088, or your <u>gift offerings</u> 5071, or <u>heave offering</u> 8641 of your hand:

18. but you must before Yahweh Eloheycha eat them in the place that chooses Yahweh Eloheycha, you, and your sons, and your daughters, and your male slaves, and your female slaves, and the Lewiy *3881* that is within your gates: and you shall rejoice *8055* before Yahweh Eloheycha in all that you <u>put to *4916*</u> your hands.

19. Guard yourselves lest you forsake 5800 the Lewiy all your days upon the soil 127.

20. For shall enlarge 7337 Yahweh Eloheycha your borders 1366, as He spoke to you, and you shall say, "I will eat flesh," for you want 183 for your beings to eat flesh, and all you desire 185 for your beings, you may eat flesh.

21. Because if <u>it is too far</u> 7368 from you is the place that chooses Yahweh Eloheycha to put 7760 His Name there, then you shall slaughter of your herd or your flock that which gives Yahweh to you that I have commanded you, and you shall eat within your gates all that desire your beings.

22. Even as are eaten the gazelle and the deer, so you shall eat: Those unclean, and those clean alike shall eat.

23. Only 7535 be sure 2388 to not 1115 eat the blood 1818: because the blood is the life 5315; and you shall not eat the life with the flesh 1320.

24. You shall not eat it, upon the ground 776 you shall pour it out 8210 as water:

25. you shall not eat it; so that it may <u>go well</u> *3190* with you, and with your children after you, when you do *6213* uprightly *3477* in the sight *5869* of Yahweh.

26. Only the <u>holy things</u> 6944 that are with you, and your vows 5088, you shall take, and go to the place that shall choose Yahweh:

27. and you shall make burnt offerings, the flesh and the blood, upon the altar of Yahweh Eloheycha: and the blood of the slaughterings 2077 shall be poured out upon the altar of Yahweh Eloheycha, and the flesh you shall eat.

28. Observe 8104 and hear 8085 all these things 1697 that I command you, that it may be well with you, and your children after you even 5704 forever 5769; when you do good 2896 and uprightly in the sight of Yahweh Eloheycha.

29. When <u>cuts off</u> 3772 Yahweh Eloheycha the nations where you go there to dispossess them before you, and you dispossess them, and dwell 3427 in the land;

30. guard yourselves lest you are snared 5367 by following 310 them, after 310 they are destroyed 8045 from before you; lest you seek after 1875 eloheyhem 430, saying, " How 349 did serve these nations eloheyhem? I will do likewise."

31. You shall not do this way to Yahweh Eloheycha: because every abomination 8441 to Yahweh, that He hates 8130, they do to eloheyhem; because even their sons and their daughters they burn 8313 in the fire 784 to eloheyhem.

Chapter 12 NOTES

Chapter 12 has several critical passages. In vs. 2-4 is the command to destroy all pagan places of worship. This includes the "Ashera poles", altars, statues, graven images, cast idols, etc There is a stern warning not to worship Yahweh in the manner of the local pagan tribes. This worship included orgies, and child sacrifice (to Molech). This is repeated graphically in vs. 30,31, clearly telling of child sacrifice by fire. In vs. 5&6, Yahweh will choose His own place of worship in the territory of one of the tribes. Later, this turns out to be Yahudah, and the place will be the Temple at Yerushalaim. In vs. 8, there is a notice that the manner of worship will change when Yisrael crosses over the Yarden River. No more "do as you feel is right" worship. In vs. 10, the term "hated enemies" is more emphatic than other words for hate. It carries racial and tribal overtones. In vs. 5 & 22, "clean" and "unclean" are "legal" terms. Touching anything unclean, such as a dead body, would render that person ritually unclean until he/she followed the procedures to ritually cleanse themselves. In vs. 16, 23-25, it again is a command not to eat blood. The local pagans ate blood, and Yisrael is to be set-apart from everyone else, in dress, circumcision, worship, and dietary practices.

Chapter 13

1. Whatever thing that I command you, you shall observe and do: you shall not add *3254* to it, nor diminish *1639* from it.

2. If there arises 6965 among you a prophet 5030, or a dreamer 2492 of dreams 2472, and gives 5414 you a sign 226, or a wonder 4159,

3. and comes to pass the sign or wonder, that he spoke to you, saying, "Let us walk *1980* after other *312* elohiym *430*, which you have not known, and serve them, "

4. you shall not listen to the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: because tests 5254 you Yahweh Eloheychem, to know whether 3426 you love 157 Yahweh Eloheychem with all your heart and all your being.

5. After Yahweh Eloheychem you shall walk, and you shall revere *3372* Him, and His commandments you shall keep, and His voice you shall listen to, and you shall serve Him, and cleave to Him.

6. And that prophet, or dreamer of dreams, put to death *4191*; because he has spoken apostasy *5627* against Yahweh; who brought you forth from the land of Mits'rayim, and redeemed *6299* you from the house of bondage, to drive *5080* you from the way of life which commanded Yahweh Eloheycha to walk in. So shall you remove *1197* evil *7451* from your midst *7130*.

7. If entices 5496 you your brother, the son of your mother, or your son, or your daughter, or the wife of your bosom 2436, or your neighbor, that is as yourself, secretly 5643, saying, "Let us walk and serve other elohiym, which you have not known, you, or your forefathers; "

8. of elohey of the people that are around you, near *7138* to you, or far *7350* from you, from one end of the land to the other end;

9. you shall not consent *14* to him, nor listen to him; neither shall your eye show pity *2347* to him, neither shall you spare *2550* him, neither shall you conceal *3680* him:

10. but you shall surely kill 2026/2026 him; your hand shall be the first 7223 upon him to put him to death 4191, and the hand of all the people afterward 314.

11. You shall stone *5619* him with stones *68*, so he dies; because he has sought to drive you from Yahweh Eloheycha, who brought you forth from the land of Mits'rayim from the house of bondage.

12. And all Yis'rael shall fear 3372, and no more do this evil among you.

13. If you hear in one of the cities that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you to dwell in there, saying,

14. that have gone forth men, sons of beliyyaal *1100*, from among you, and have thrust aside the dwellers of the city, saying, "Let us walk and serve other elohiym, that you have not known,"

15. then you shall inquire *1875*, and search *2713*, and ask *7592* well *3190*; and behold, the thing is true *571* and certain *3554*, that is done this abomination among you;

16. then you shall <u>surely smite</u> *5221/5221* the dwellers of that city with the edge *6310* of the sword, destroying *2763* it, and all that is in it, and the beasts of it by the edge of the sword.

17. And all the spoil 7998 you shall gather 6908 into the middle 8432 of the street 7339, and shall burn with fire the city, and all the spoil, <u>all of it</u> 3632, for Yahweh Eloheycha: and it shall be a heap 8510 forever 5769; it shall not be rebuilt 1129 again 5750.

18. And there shall not cleave 1692 to your hand anything 3972 from the cursed thing 2674: so that may turn 7725 Yahweh from the fierceness 2740 of His anger 639, and give you mercy 7356, and have compassion 7355 upon you, and multiply 7235 you as He swore 7650 to your forefathers;

19. for you shall listen 8085 to the voice 6963 of Yahweh Eloheycha, to guard 8104 all the commandments 4687 that I command you this day, to do uprightly 3477 in the eyes of Yahweh Eloheycha.

CHAPTER 13 NOTES

In verse 1 is the admonition not to add to the commandments, such as those added by the followers of the Babylonian Talmud, which are "rabbinical commands". This is the apostasy which Yahshua Messiah reviled them for in the B'riyth Chadashah (New Covenant). Also they were warned not to delete any of the commands, which the current "judeo-christian churches" are busily doing. This includes the keeping of pagan holidays, and calling them "Christian" (Christmas, Easter, and worshipping on "SUN-day"). You cannot "Christianize" paganism. Yahweh will not accept it. It is forbidden to have a mamzer one of mixed blood, a mongrel) in Yisrael's congregation, but these "churches" promote this heavily. Yahshua came only for the lost sheep of the house of Yisrael.

Chapter 13 References

Verse 1 – Deut. 4:6; Rev. 22:18,19;

Verses 2-4 deal with a warning about false prophets and dreamers. We see this today, with "churches" following doctrine based on the teaching of this type.

Verses 6-11 deals with family and friends that worship false deities. Yahweh is the only Deity, and the penalty is death for our people that break away into apostasy.

Verses 12-17 deal with cities that go into apostasy. Total destruction, and death by the sword. Even the spoils are unclean to us, and must be destroyed by fire. Yahweh has no forgiveness over the worship of false deities. Read 2 Thessalonians 1:6-10 to see what Yahshua Messiah will do upon His return.

Chapter 14

1. You are the children of Yahweh Eloheychem: you shall not cut yourselves *1413* in mourning, and shall not make *7760* any baldness *7144* between *996* your eyes *5869* for the dead *4191*.

2. Because you are a Holy *6918* people to Yahweh Eloheycha: and you has chosen *977* Yahweh to be His treasured *5459* people, of all *3605* the nations *5971* that are upon the face of the land.

3. You shall not eat any <u>abominable thing</u> 8441.

4. These are the beasts 929 which you shall eat: the ox 7794, the sheep 3775 of the flock 7716, and the goat 5795 of the flock.

5. The deer 354, and the gazelle 6643, and the roebuck 3180, and the wild goat 689, and the ibex 1788, and the wild ox 8377, and the mountain sheep 2169.

6. Every beast that divides 6536 the hoof 6541, and divides 8156 the divide 8157 into two 8147 hooves, and <u>brings up</u> 5927 the cud 1625 among the beasts, that you shall eat.

7. Nevertheless these you shall not eat of those that bring up the cud, or of them that divide the divided hoof; the camel 1581, and the hare 768, and the hyrax 8227: because they bring up the cud, but do not divide the hoof; they are unclean 2931 to you.

8. And the swine 2386, because it divides the hoof, yet does not bring up the cud, it is unclean to you: you shall not eat of their flesh, nor touch 5060 their dead carcass 5038.

9. These you shall eat of all that are in the waters: all that have fins 5579 and scales 7193 you shall eat:

10. and whatever does not have fins and scales you may not eat ; it is unclean to you.

11. All birds 6833 that are clean 2889 you shall eat.

12. But these 2088 are what you shall not eat: the eagle 5404, and the ossifrage 6538, and the buzzard 5822,

13. and the raah 7201, and the falcon 344, and the dayah 1772 after their species 4327.

14. Every raven 6158 after its species,

15. And the daughter *1323* of the ostrich *3284*, and the male ostrich *8464*, and the seagull *7828*, and the hawk *5322* after its species,

16. the little owl 3563, and the great owl 3244, and the [tineshemets 8580],

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17. and the pelican 6893, and the carrion vulture 7360, and the cormorant 7994,

18. and the stork 2624, and the [anapah 601] after its species, and the hoopoe 1744, and the bat 5847.

19. And every <u>creeping thing</u> 8318 that flies 5775 is unclean to you, they shall not be eaten.

20. All birds that are clean you may eat.

21. You shall not eat of any <u>dead carcass</u> 5038: you shall give it to the sojourner 1616 that is within your gates, that he may eat it; or you may sell 4376 it to a <u>racial alien</u> 5237: because you are a Holy 6918 People to Yahweh Eloheycha. You shall not boil 1310 a kid 1423 in its mother's milk 2461.

22. You shall <u>truly tithe</u> 6237/6237 all the increase 8393 of your seed 2233 that the field brings forth year by year.

23. And you shall eat before Yahweh Eloheycha, in the place which He shall choose to establish *7931* His Name there; the tithe of your corn *1715*, of your <u>new wine</u> *8492*, and of your <u>fresh oil</u> *3323*, and of the firstborn *1062* of your herds *1241* and of your flocks *6629*; so that you may learn *3925* to revere *3372* Yahweh Eloheycha all the days.

24. And if the way is <u>too much</u> 7235 for you, so that you are not able to bear 5375 it; if the place is <u>too far</u> 7368 from you, when Yahweh Eloheycha shall choose to set 7760 His Name there, when Yahweh Eloheycha has blessed 1288 you:

25. then you shall give *5414* it as silver *3701*, and <u>bind up</u> *6696* the silver in your hand, and you shall go to the place which Yahweh Eloheycha shall choose:

26. and you shall bestow *5414* that silver for all that your being desires *183*, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink *7941*, or for all that your being desires *7592*: and you shall eat there before Yahweh and you shall rejoice *8053*, you and your household,

27. and the Lewiy *3881* that is within your gates; you shall not forsake *5800* them; because they have no portion *2506* or inheritance *5159* with you.

28. At the end of three years you shall bring forth all the tithe of your increase the same year, and it shall rest *5117* within your gates:

29. and the Lewiy, because he has no portion or inheritance with you, and the sojourner *1616*, and the fatherless child *3490*, and the widow *490*, which are within your gates, shall come, and shall eat and be satisfied *7646*; so that Yahweh Eloheycha may bless you in all the work *4639* of your hands which you do.

CHAPTER 14 NOTES

Chapter 14 is a repeating of Levitical laws for the younger generation of Yisrael.

Verse l concerns pagan mourning practices of cutting oneself ritually, and shaving of the hair above the forehead. Lev. 19:28; 21:5;

Verses 2-21 are food laws. Many of the words for the species are either lost, or unclear in meaning, or probable meanings.

Verse 7 – Lev. 11:4-6; 768 unknown species, 8227 another species of rabbit;

Verse 8 – Lev. 11:7;

Verse 9 – Lev. 11:9;

Verses 11-20 -Lev. 11:13-19;

Verse 13 - 7201 unclear species; 1722 a bird of prey; 7201 and 1722 are not in Leviticus;

The last part of verse 21 is a subject of controversy. It does not say to not eat meat and milk together. This stipulation is a rabbinical pronouncement from long ago, and is another of the added regulations of orthodox Judaism from their Babylonian Talmud. It is not a command from Yahweh, but a "tradition of men." See Deut. 12:32.

Verses 22-29 have to do with tithing. Lev. 27:30 – 33; Num. 18:21;

Verse 26 – *7941* is a type of beer.

Chapter 15

1. At the end of seven years you shall make a remission 8059 of debt.

2. And this is the manner of remission: every creditor 1167/4874/3027 that lends 5383 to another 7453 shall let it fall 8058; he shall not exact 3027 of your hand 5065 it of his neighbor, or his kindred 251; because it is called Yahweh's remission.

3. Of a <u>racial alien</u> *5237* you may exact it: but what is yours with your racial kindred your hand shall let fall;

4. Ceasing 657 when there shall be no poor 34 among you; because Yahweh shall greatly bless you in the land which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you as an inheritance 5159 to possess 3423.

5. Only if *518* you carefully listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha, to observe *8104* and do *6213* all these commandments *4687* which I command *6680* you this day.

6. Because Yahweh Eloheycha blesses you, as He has spoken to you: and you shall take pledges from 5670 many, but you shall not give a pledge 5670; and you shall reign 4910

over many nations, but they shall not reign over you.

7. If there is among you a <u>poor man</u> 34 of your racial kindred within any of your gates in your land which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you, you shall not harden 553 your heart, nor shut 7092 your hand from your poor kinsman:

8. But you shall open 6605 your hand wide 6605 to him, and shall surely lend 5670/5670 him sufficient 1767 for his need 4270, what he lacks 2637.

9. Guard *8104* that there is not a wicked *1100* thought *1697* in your mind *3824*, saying, "The seventh year, the year of remission is near," and your eye *5869* is evil *7489* against your poor kinsman, and you give him nothing; and he cries *7121* to Yahweh against you, and it is sin *2399* to you.

10. You shall surely give to him, and your heart shall not be grieved 7489 when you give to him: because for this thing shall bless you Yahweh Eloheycha in all your works, and in all that you put your hands to.

11. Because the poor shall never cease 2308 from within 7130 the land: therefore I command you, saying, "You shall open your hand wide to your kinsman, to your poor 6041 and to the needy 34 in your land.

12. And if your kinsman, an Ibriy *5880*, or an Ibriyyah *5880*, is sold *4376* to you, and serves you *5647* six years; then in the seventh year you shall let him go free *2670* from you.

13. And when you let him go free from you, you shall not let him go empty 7387 handed.

14. You shall <u>supply him well</u> 6059/6059 from your flock, and from your threshing floor, and from your winepress: by which Yahweh Eloheycha has blessed you, you shall give to him.

15. And you shall remember that you were slaves *5650* in the land of Mits'rayim, and Yahweh Eloheycha redeemed *6299* you: therefore I command you this thing this day.

16. And it shall be, if he says to you, "I will not go away from you; because he loves 157 you and your household, because he is <u>well off</u> 2895 with you:

17. then you shall take an awl 4836, and put 5414 it through his ear into the door 1817, and he shall be your slave 5650 forever. And also to your female servant 519 you shall do likewise.

18. It shall not seem hard 7185 in your eyes when you send him away from you; because he has been worth the wages 7939 of two 4932 hired servants 7916, in serving you six years: and Yahweh Eloheycha shall bless you in all you do.

19. All the firstborn *1060* males *2145* that are born of your herd and your flock you shall consecrate *6942* to Yahweh Eloheycha: you shall do no <u>servile work</u> *5647* with the firstborn of your cattle, nor shear *1494* the firstborn of your sheep.

20. You shall eat it before Yahweh Eloheycha year by year in the place which Yahweh shall choose, you, and your household.

21. And if there is any blemish *3971* in it, lame *6455*, or blind *5787*, or any ill *7451* blemish, you shall not slaughter *2076* it to Yahweh Eloheycha.

22. You shall eat it within your gates: the unclean 2931 and the clean 2889 person alike, as the gazelle 6643 and the deer 354.
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23. Only you shall not eat the blood of it: you shall pour it upon the ground as water.

CHAPTER 15 NOTES

Chapter 16

1. Observe 8104 the month of Abiyb 24, and keep 6213 the Passover 6453 to Yahweh Eloheycha: because in the month of Abiyb Yahweh Eloheycha brought you forth from Mits' rayim by night.

2. You shall therefore slaughter 2076 the Passover to Yahweh Eloheycha, of the flock and the herd, in the place which Yahweh shall choose to establish 7931 His Name there.

3. You shall eat no leaven 2557 with it; seven days you shall eat matsoth 4682 with it, the bread 3899 of affliction 6040; because you came forth from the land of Mits'rayim in haste 2649: so that you may remember 2142 the day when you came forth from the land of Mits'rayim all the days of your life.

4. And shall not be seen 7200 with you leaven 7603 in all your territory 1366 for seven days; neither shall there remain 3885 any of the flesh which you slaughtered at evening 6153 of the first day until the morning 1242.

5. You may not slaughter the Passover within any of your gates *8179*, that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you:

6. but at the place which Yahweh Eloheycha shall choose to establish His Name there you shall slaughter the Passover at evening, at the <u>going down</u> 935 of the sun 8121, at the <u>appointed time</u> 4150 that you came forth from Mits'rayim.

7. and you shall cook 1310 and eat in the place which Yahweh Eloheycha shall choose: and you shall turn 6437 in the morning, and go to your tents.

8. Six days you shall eat matsoth: and on the seventh day is a <u>solemn assembly</u> *6116* to Yahweh Eloheycha: you shall do no work *4399*.

9. Seven weeks 7620 you shall number 5608 to you: begin 2490 to number the seven weeks from when you begin to put the sickle 2770 to the standing grain 7054.

10. You shall keep 6213 the Feast 2282 of Weeks 7620 to Yahweh Eloheycha with a tribute 4350 of a gift offering 5071 of your hand, which you shall give 5414, according as Yahweh Eloheycha has blessed you:

11. And you shall rejoice *8055* before Yahweh Eloheycha, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your male slave, and your female slave, and the Lewiy that is within your gates, and the

sojourner *1616*, and the fatherless child, and the widow, that are among you, in the place which Yahweh Eloheycha has chosen to establish His Name.

12. And you shall remember that you were a slave in Mits'rayim: and you shall observe *8104* and do *6213* these statutes.

13. And the Feast of Booths *5521* you shall keep *6213* seven days, after you have gathered *622* from your threshing floor *1637*, and your winepress *3342*.

14. And you shall rejoice in your feast, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your male slave, and your female slave, and the Lewiy, and the sojourner, and the fatherless child, and the widow, that are within your gates.

15. Seven days you shall be a <u>solemn feast</u> 2287 to Yahweh Eloheycha in the place that Yahweh shall choose; because Yahweh Eloheycha shall bless you in all your increase 8393, and in all the work 4639 of your hands, and it shall be you will surely rejoice.

16. Three times a year, shall be seen 7200 all your males 2138 before Yahweh Eloheycha in the place that He shall choose; in the Feast of Matsoth, and in the Feast of Weeks, and in the Feast of Booths: and they shall not be seen before Yahweh empty handed.

17. Every man with his gift 4979 in his hand according to the blessing of Yahweh Eloheycha which He has given you.

18. Judges *8199* and officers *7860* you shall put in all your gates, which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you throughout your tribes *7626*: and they shall judge *8199* the people with justice *4941* and righteousness *6664*.

19. You shall not twist *5186* justice *4941*; you shall not be partial to *5234* personages *6440*, neither take *3947* a bribe *7810*: for a bribe blinds *5786* the eyes *5869* of the wise *2450*, and perverts *5557* the words of the righteous *6662*.

20. That which is altogether righteous *6664/6664* you shall pursue *7291*, so that you may live, and possess *3423* the land which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you.

21. You shall not plant 5193 trees 6086 to Ashera 842 near 681 the altar 4196 of Yahweh Eloheycha, which you shall make you.

22. Neither shall you set up 6965 obelisks 4676 to the sun; which Yahweh Eloheycha hates 8130.

Chapter 17

1. You shall not slaughter to Yahweh Eloheycha any bullock 7794 or sheep 7716 in which is any blemish 3971, or any harmful 7451 matter 1697: because that is abomination 8441 to Yahweh Eloheycha.

2. If there is found among you, within any of your gates which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you, man or woman, that does wickedness 7451 in the sight of Yahweh Eloheycha, in transgressing 5674 His Covenant 1285,

3. and has walked *1980* in service *5647* to other *312* elohiym *430*, and prostrated *7812* to them, either the sun *8121*, moon *3394*, or any of the host *6635* of the sky, which I have not commanded;

4. and it is reported *5046* to you, and you have heard *8085*, and inquired *1875* well *3190*, and, behold, it is true *571*, the matter is certain *3559*, such abomination is done in Yisrael:

5. you shall bring forth that man or that woman, that has done this thing of wickedness, to your gates, that man or that woman, and shall stone *5619* them with stones *68*, until they die.

6. At the mouth of two 8147 witnesses 5707, or three 7969 witnesses, shall he that is worthy of death 4191 be <u>put to death</u> 4191; but shall not be put to death by the mouth of one 259 witness.

7. The hands of the witnesses shall be the first 7223 to put him to death, and the hands of all the people afterwards 314, to remove 1197 the wickedness 7451 from among you 7130.

8. If there is too hard 6381 a matter 1697 among you for judgement 4941, between 996 blood 1818 and blood, between cause 1779 and cause, and between wound 5061 and wound, matters of controversy 7379 within your gates: then you shall arise 6965, and go up to the place that has been chosen by Yahweh Eloheycha;

9. and you shall go to the priests 3548 of the Lewiyyim 3881, and to the judge 8199 that shall be in those days, and inquire 1875; and they shall declare 5046 to you the matter of judgement.

10. And you shall act 6213 upon the the words 6310 of the matter, that are declared to you from the place that has chosen Yahweh; and shall observe 8104 and do 6213 all that they direct 3384 you:

11. upon the words 6310 of the Torah 8451 by which they direct you, and upon the judgement that they say to you, you shall do: you shall not turn aside from the matter that they declare to you to the <u>right hand</u> 3225 or the left 8040.

12. The man that does 6213 presumptuously 2087, and fails 1115 to listen 8085 to the priest that stands 5975 as minister 8334 there to Yahweh Eloheycha, or to the judge; that man shall die 4191. You shall remove wickedness from Yisrael;

13. and all the people shall hear 8085, and fear 3372, and not act presumptuously 2102 any more 5750.

14. When you have come into the land which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you, and shall possess it, and shall dwell in it, and shall say, "We will set a king over us, like all the nations around 5439 us;"

15. You shall in any wise set a king over you, whom Yahweh Eloheycha shall choose: from among your kinsmen 251 you shall set a king over you: you may 3201 not 3808 set 5414 a man

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376 of <u>alien race</u> 5237 over you, which is not 3808 your kinsman.

16. But he shall not multiply 7235 horses 5438 for himself, nor <u>cause to return</u> 7725 the people to Mits'rayim, and for that reason 4616 he should multiply horses: because Yahweh has said to you, "You shall not return that way again anymore."

17. Neither shall he multiply wives *802* for himself, so that his heart does not <u>turn away</u> *5493*: neither shall he multiply to himself silver and gold.

18. and it shall be, when he sits upon the throne of his kingdom that he shall write *3789* a copy *4932* of this Torah *8451* in a scroll *5612* before the priests of the Lewiyyim.

19. And it shall be with him, and he shall read it aloud 7121 all the days of his life: so that he may learn to revere 3372 Yahweh Elohayv 430, to observe 8104 all the words of this Torah, and these statutes 2706, and do 6213 them:

20. so that his heart is not <u>lifted up</u> 7311 above his kinsmen, and so that he does not turn aside from the commandments 4687, to the right hand, or to the left: to the end that that he may lengthen 748 his days in his kingdom; he, and his children, in the midst of Yisrael.

Chapter 18

1. It shall not be for the priests of the Lewiyyim, and all the tribe 7626 of Lewiy to have a portion or inheritance with Yisrael: the <u>offerings made by fire</u> 801 to Yahweh is their inheritance, and what they shall eat.

2. An inheritance they shall not have among their kinsmen: Yahweh is their inheritance, as He has spoken to them.

3. This shall be the just portion of the priests from the people: of the slaughterings 2076 of sacrifice 2077, whether ox, or sheep; they shall give the priest the shoulder 2220, and the two cheeks 3895, and the stomach 6896.

4. The firstfruits 7225 of your grain 1715, of your <u>new wine</u> 8492, and of your <u>fresh oil</u> 3323, and the first of the fleece 1488 of your flocks, you shall give them.

5. Because has chosen them Yahweh Eloheycha from all your tribes, to stand and minister in The Name of Yahweh, they, and their sons for all the days.

6. Because if comes a Lewiy from one of your gates from all Yisrael, that he sojourned there, and comes with all the desire *185* of his being *5315* to the place that has chosen Yahweh;

7. then he shall minister in The Name of Yahweh Elohayv, as all his kindred the Lewiyyim, which stand there before Yahweh.

8. Like portions 2506/2506 they shall eat, besides what comes from the sale 4465 of [patrimonies 1].

9. When you have come into the land which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you, you shall not learn *3925* to do the abominations *8441* of those nations.

10. There shall not be found among you any that pass through 5674 his son or daughter the fire 784, or that practice 7080 divination 7081, or a soothsayer 6049, or an enchanter 5172, or a sorcerer 3784,

11. or a charmer 2266 of spells 2267, or a consulter 7592 by necromancy 178 of a <u>familiar spirit</u> 3049, one who inquires 1875 of the dead 4191.

12. For an abomination to Yahweh are all that do these things, and because of these abominations Yahweh Eloheycha drives them out from before you.

13. You shall be blameless *8549* with Yahweh Eloheycha.

14. Because these nations, which you shall dispossess *3423*, listened to soothsayers, and practiced divination: but as for you, Yahweh Eloheycha has not allowed *5414* you so.

15. A prophet *5030* from the midst of you, of your racial kindred *251*, <u>like unto me</u> *3644* will raise up *6965* to you Yahweh Eloheycha. To him you shall listen;

16. according to all you shall ask 7592 from Yahweh Eloheycha in Choreb 2722 in the day of the assembly 6951, saying, "Let me not again hear the voice of Yahweh Elohayv 430, neither let me see the great fire anymore, that I not die."

17. And said Yahweh to me, "They have <u>done well</u> 3190 by that they have spoken.

18. I will raise them up a prophet from among their racial kinsmen, like to you, and I will put My Words in his mouth; and he shall speak to them all that I command him.

19. And it shall be, whoever will not listen to My Words, which he shall *1349* speak in My Name, I will <u>exact it</u> *1875* from him.

20. But a prophet, who presumes 2102 to speak a word in My Name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other 312 elohiym, that prophet shall die.

21. And if you say in your mind, 'How shall we know the word which Yahweh has not spoken?'

22. When a prophet speaks in The Name of Yahweh, if the thing does not come to be, that is the thing that Yahweh has not spoken, and the prophet has spoken it presumptuously 2087: you shall not fear 1481 him."

CHAPTER 18 NOTES

This chapter is straightforward as to what is due the priests, and to what pagan practices are forbidden. Verses 10 and 11 are a mess in the KJV, so I have listed all the transliterated words in the margin notes with Strong's Numbers. In verses 15-22 it foretells of a coming prophet like

Mosheh. Yahshua son of Nun will be chosen by Yahweh to lead Yisrael into the promised land. In verses 20-22, it clearly points out what occurs with a false prophet. This includes today's deceivers, who will be cast into the lake of fire for their second death.

Chapter 19

1. When has <u>cut off</u> 3772 Yahweh Eloheycha the nations that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you for their land, and you dispossess 3423 them and dwell in their cities, and their houses,

2. three cities you shall set apart to you in the midst of your land, that Yahweh Eloheycha give you to possess.

3. You shall prepare 3559 a way, and divide into <u>three parts</u> 8027 the territory 1366 of your land, that gives you to inherit 5157 Yahweh Eloheycha, to be a place for fleeing 5127 there for all slayers 7523.

4. And this is the matter of the slayer which shall flee there, that he may live: whoever smites *5221* to death another without *1097* knowledge *1847*, whom he has not hated *8130* in times *8032* past *8543*;

5. As a man goes with another 7453 into the woods 3293 to hew 2404 trees 6086, and he wields 5080 with his hand an axe 1631 to cut down 3772 the tree, and <u>drops off</u> 5394 the <u>iron axe head</u> 1270 from the handle 6086, and hits 4672 his neighbor 7453, and he dies; he shall flee 5127 to one of these cities, and live:

6. lest 6435 pursue 7291 the kinsman avenger 1350 of blood 1818 the slayer 7523, while hot 3179 is his heart 3824 with anger, and overtake 5381 him, because long 7235 is the way 1870, and he smites his being; and it is not 369 just 4941 that he die 4191, for he had not hated 8130 him in times 8032 past 8543.

7. Upon this I command you, saying, 'Three cities you shall set apart.'

8. And if enlarges 7337 Yahweh Eloheycha your borders 1366, as He swore 7650 to your forefathers, and gives you all the land that He spoke of to give your forefathers;

9. for you shall observe *8104* all these commandments *4687* and do them, that I command this day, to love *157* Yahweh Eloheycha, and walk in His Way *1870* all the days; you shall add *3254* three more cities, besides these three.

10. There shall not be poured out 8210 the blood of innocents 5355 within 7130 your land, that

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Yahweh Eloheycha gives you as an inheritance, and upon you is blood guilt 1818.

11. but if it is that the man hated his neighbor, and <u>lies in wait</u> 693, and <u>rises up</u> 6965 upon him, and smites his being so he dies, and flees into one of these cities:

12. then shall send 7971 the elders 2205 of his own city and take 3947 him from there, and give him into the hand of the kinsman avenger of blood, so he may die.

13. No pity 2347 shall be in your eyes upon him, and you shall remove the blood guilt of the innocent from Yis'rael, that it <u>be well</u> 2896 with you.

14. You shall not move 5253 the boundary 1366 of your neighbor 7453, which was set 1379 beforetimes 7223 in your inheritance 5159, that you shall inherit 5157 in the land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you to possess 3423.

15. There shall not rise up one witness against a man for any iniquity 5771, or any sin 2403, of all sins 2399 that he sins 2398: by the mouth 6310 of two 8147 witnesses, or by the mouth of three 7969 witnesses, shall rise up the matter.

16. If rise up witnesses harmful 2555 against a man to answer 6030 in defection 5627:

17. then shall stand *5975* both the men that have controversy *7389* before Yahweh, before the priests and the judges, which shall be in those days;

18. and shall inquire *1875* the judges well *3190*: and behold, if the witness is a false *8267* witness, and has answered falsely against his kinsman;

19. then you shall do to him that which he had planned *2161* to do to his kinsman. So you shall remove *1197* wickedness *7451* from among you.

20. And those that remain 7604 shall hear, and fear, and shall not again do anymore this wickedness among you.

21. And shall not pity 2347 your eye 5869; life 5315 for life, eye 5869 for eye, tooth 8127 for tooth, hand 3027 for hand, foot 7272 for foot.

CHAPTER 19 NOTES

Chapter 19 is simple, common sense law. The innocent have a safe refuge if they accidentally kill someone, and a deliberate murderer gets turned over to the victim's family for execution. False witnesses get the same punishment they tried to cause to their kinsman by " framing him" with their lies. What perfect justice this is under Yahweh's Law! Why have we allowed this to be changed?

Chapter 20

1. When you go forth to battle *4421* against your hated enemies, and see horses and chariots, a people more numerous than you, do not fear them: because Yahweh Eloheycha is with you, that brought you up from the land of Mits'rayim.

2. And it shall be, when you <u>come near</u> 7126 to the battle, that shall approach 5066 the priest and speak to the people,

3. and shall say to them, "Hear, Yisrael! You approach 7131 this day to battle against your hated enemies: do not be fearful 7390 in your hearts 3824, do not 408 fear 3372, and do not flee 2648, and do not be terrified 6206 of their presence;

4. for Yahweh Eloheychem walks *1980* with you, to fight *3898* for you against your hated enemies, to deliver *3467* you.

5. And shall speak the officers 7860 to the people, saying, "What man is there that has built 1129 a new 2319 house, and has not dedicated 2596 it? Let him go to return to his house, lest he die in battle, and another man dedicates it.

6. And what man has planted *5193* a vineyard *3754*, and has not <u>eaten of it</u> *2490*? Let him go and return to his house, lest he die in battle, and another man eats of it.

7. And what man has betrothed 781 a wife, and has not taken 3947 her? Let him go, and return to his house, lest he die in battle, and another man takes her."

8. And the officers shall speak further 3254 to the people, and they shall say, "What man is fearful 3373 and weak 7390 of heart 3824? Let him go and return to his house, lest his kinsmen's hearts melt 4549 as his heart."

9. And it shall be, when have made an end *3615* the officers of speaking to the people, that they shall appoint *6485* commanders *8269* of the armies *6635* to lead *7218* the people.

10. When you come near to a city to fight against it, proclaim 7121 to it peace 7965.

11. And it shall be, if peace they answer you, and it opens *6605* to you, then it shall be, all the people found in it shall become <u>forced laborers</u> *4522*, and shall serve *5647* you.

12. But if it will not make peace with you, but will do battle with you, then you shall <u>lay siege</u> 6696 upon it.

13. And when gives Yahweh Eloheycha the city into your hand, you shall smite all the males *2138* with the edge of the sword,

14. but the women, and the little ones 2945, and the beasts 929, and all that is in the city, all the spoil 7998 of it, you shall plunder 962 for yourself; and you shall eat of the spoil of your hated enemies 341, which has given Yahweh Eloheycha to you.

15. Thus you shall do to all the cities very *3966* <u>far off</u> *7350* from you, which are not of the cities of these nations.

16. But of the cities of the cursed seedline people, these that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you for an inheritance, nothing shall live *2421* of all that breathes *5397*:

17. but you shall utterly destroy 2763/2763 them; namely the Chittiy 2850, the Emoriy 567, the Kenaaniy 3669, the Perizziy 6522, the Chiwwiy 2348, and the Yebusiy 2983, as that which commanded to you Yahweh Eloheycha:

18. so that they do not teach 3925 you to do all their abominations 8441 that they do for eloheyhem 430, and you sin against 2398 Yahweh Eloheychem.

19. When you lay siege upon a city for a long time, in making war upon it to capture 8610 it, you shall not destroy 7843 the fruit bearing trees of it by bringing against them an axe 1631: for you may eat of them, and shall not cut them down. Is the tree of the field an adam 120 to go before 6440 you as siege works 4692?

20. Only the trees which you know are not trees for food *3978*, you shall destroy by cutting down; and you shall build siege works against the city that does war against you until it is brought down.

CHAPTER 20 NOTES

Chapter 20 is all about battles. There are two different types of cities that Yisrael would have to deal with. The first are non-cursed-seedline cities, in which they have a chance for peace. If they choose peace, they will become servants to Yisrael, and do forced labor. If they did not choose peace, only the men would be killed, but not the women and children. The second type of city is that of the cursed-seedline people. All of the cursed-seedline people were to be killed, including the women and children. All their possessions, and livestock were to be spoils of war for Yisrael. Yahweh did not want the pure Adamic bloodline of Yisrael mixed with racial aliens, nor for them to learn and adopt the pagan worship practices of the alien people. Yisrael did not completely wipe out these people, and the resulting mixture plagues us yet today. The pretenders that call themselves Jews are of mixed seedline, and have adopted Babylonian Talmudism as their "religion". Much of the Talmud goes entirely contrary to Scripture, and it is a bunch of "rabbinical commandments" of men. Yahshua Messiah reviled these mixed-seedliners for this, as they had infiltrated even the priesthood in those days. Only pureblood Yisrael is Yisrael, and any mixing disqualifies that individual from the name Yisrael, as it is a polluting of the Holy Seedline.

Chapter 21

1. If there is found one slain 2491 in your land 127 that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you to possess, fallen in the field, and it is not known who smote 5221 him,

2. then shall go forth your elders 2205 and your judges 8199, and they shall measure 4058 to the cities that are around he that was slain.

3. And it shall be, the city closest 7138 to the slain, that shall take the elders of that city a heifer 5697 of the herd 1241, that has not been worked 5647, that has not drawn 4900 in the yoke 5923;

4. and shall bring forth the elders of the city the heifer to an ever flowing *386* wadi *5158*, that is neither tilled *5647* nor sown *2232*, and shall break *6202* the neck there of the heifer in the wadi.

5. And shall come near the priests, the sons of Lewiy: for has chosen them Yahweh Eloheycha to minister 8334 to Him, and to bless in The Name of Yahweh, and by their word every controversy 7379 and every wound 5061 shall be tried:

6. And all the elders of that city, closest to the slain, shall wash 7364 their hands over the heifer whose neck was broken in the wadi:

7. and they shall answer 6030 and say, "Our hands have not poured out 8210 this blood, neither have our eyes seen it.

8. Forgive *3722* for Your people Yis'rael, that You have redeemed 6299 O Yahweh, and do not place blood guilt of the innocent *5355* in the midst *7130* of Your people Yis'rael." And forgiven them shall be the blood guilt.

9. And so you shall remove *1197* the blood guilt of the innocent from among you, because you shall do uprightly *3477* in the eyes of Yahweh.

10. When you go forth to war against your hated enemies, and has given them Yahweh Eloheycha into your hand, and you have transported *7617* them into captivity *7628*,

11. and you see among the captives 7633 an *adamic* woman of beautiful 3303 appearance 8389, and become attached 2836 to her, and you would take her to wife;

12. you shall bring her from among them 8432 to your house; and she shall shave 1548 her head, and attend to 6213 her fingernails 6856;

13. and she shall put aside 5493 the mantle 8071 of her captivity 7628 from upon her, and shall remain in your house, and bewail 1058 her father and her mother a month 3391 of days 3117. And after that you shall go in unto her, and be her husband 1166, and she shall be your wife.

14. And it shall be, if you have no delight 2654 in her, then you shall let her go wherever she wills; but you shall not sell her at all 4376/4376 for money, and you shall not treat her as a slave 6014, because you have humbled 6031 her.

15. If a man has two wives, one loved *157*, and another hated *8130*, and they have born *3205* him children, the loved and the hated; and the firstborn son is of her that was hated *8146*:

16. it shall be, in the day of the inheritance of his sons, that it be he may not be able to make *1069* the son of the beloved before the son of the hated, as the firstborn.

17. Because the firstborn son of the hated he shall acknowledge 5234, and give his portion 6310 double 8147 of all that he has found 4672: because he is the beginning 7225 of his manly vigor 202; and is the right 4941 of the firstborn.

18. For it shall be if a man has a son that is stubborn 5637 and rebellious 4784, and does not listen to the voice of his father, and the voice of his mother, when they have chastened 3256 him, and will not listen to them,

19. then shall sieze *8610* him his father and his mother, and bring him forth to the elders of the city, to the gate of his place;

20. and shall say to the elders of the city, "This our son is stubborn and rebellious, and does not listen to our voice; and is a worthless *2151* drunkard *5433*."

21. And shall stone him 7275 all the men of the city with stones 68 so he dies. So you shall remove wickedness from among you; and all Yis'rael shall hear, and fear 3372.

22. For if it be a man has sinned 2399, and the judgement 4941 is death 4194, and he is <u>put to</u> <u>death</u> 4191, and you hang 8518 him on a tree 6086;

23. shall not remain all night 3885 his dead body 5038 upon the tree, but you shall surely bury 6912/6912 him that day. Because he that is hanged 8518 is accursed 7045 of Elohiym; so that

your land is not defiled 2930, which Yahweh Eloheycha gives you as an inheritance.

CHAPTER 21 NOTES

The first part of Chapter 21 has to do with the murder of a man by an unknown assailant, and the discharge of the blood-guilt by breaking the neck of a young ox. Blood-guilt is a serious matter to Yahweh, and punishment of a murderer must follow. We do not follow Scriptural law today, and Yahweh's wrath is becoming more evident in all the punishments coming upon us.

The second part of 21 shows the treatment due a captured ADAMIC woman, and fair treatment for wives and sons. Non-adamics were not taken captive, but were commanded to be slain. A man of Yisrael was not to marry a racial alien, under the pain of death. As to the stoning of the drunken rebellious son; this may be an allegorical and not literal, as a moral example. The third part of 21 speaks of a man hanged on a tree, and his curse. Yahshua Messiah was hung on a tree, and his "curse" is our curse of death from sin. He died to give us a chance to avoid the "second death" in judgement. Also, in reference to Galatians 3: 13, Yahuda Ish-Kerioth (Judas Iskerioth), meaning Yahudah, man of Kerioth in Hebrew, hung himself after the betrayal of Yahshua, and died in his sins, cursed by Yahweh.

Chapter 22

1. You shall not see your kinsman's 251 ox 7794 or his sheep 7716 go astray 5080, and <u>hide</u> yourself 5956 from them: you shall <u>surely return</u> 7725/7725 them to your kinsman.

2. And if he is not a near 7138 kinsman to you, or if you do not know who he is, then you shall gather 622 it to the midst 8432 of your house, and it shall be with you until that kinsman seeks after 1875 it, and you shall return it to him.

3. In a like manner 3651 you shall do with his ass 2543; and you shall do with his his mantle 8071; and with all <u>lost things</u> 9 of your kinsman's, which he lost 6, and you have found 4672, and you shall do likewise: you may not hide yourself.

4. You shall not see your kinsman's ass, or his ox fall down by the wayside, and hide yourself from them: you shall surely <u>raise them up</u> 6965 together 5973.

5. A woman 802 shall not wear garments 3627 of a man 1397, neither shall a man <u>put on</u> 3847 a woman's garment 8071; because all that do so are abomination 8441 to Yahweh Eloheycha.

6. If you <u>come across</u> 7122 a bird's 6833 nest 7064 before you in the way, in any tree, or on the ground, with <u>young ones</u> 667 or eggs 1000, and the mother 517 is laying 7257 upon the young, or upon the eggs, you shall not take the mother with the young:

7. but you shall <u>surely let go</u> 7971/7971 the mother, and take the young to you; that it may be well with you, and you may lengthen 748 your days.

8. When you build a new house, you shall make a parapet *4624* for your roof, so that you do not bring blood guilt upon your house, if anyone falls from there.

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9. You shall not sow 2232 your vineyard 3754 with <u>mixed seed</u> 3610, lest be made unholy 6942 the harvest 3754 of the seed 2233 which you have sown, and the harvest of your vineyard.

10. You shall not plow 2790 with an ox and an ass together 3162.

11. You shall not wear 3827 mixed materials 8162 of wool 6785 and linen 6593 together.

12. Tassels *1434* you shall make upon the four *702* corners *3671* of your covering *3682* with which you <u>cover yourself</u> *3680*.

13. If any man takes a wife, and goes in to her, and hates *8130* her,

14. and charges 7760 wanton 5949 matters 1697 against her, and brings forth upon her a name that is evil 7451, and says, "I took this woman, and when I approached 7126 her, I found 4672 no 3808 virginity 1331."

15. Then shall take the father of the damsel *5291*, and her mother, and shall come forth with the <u>virginity token</u> *1331* of the damsel to the elders of the city in the gate;

16. and shall say the father of the damsel to the elders, "My daughter *1323* I gave to this man as a wife, and he hates her;

17. and behold, he places 7760 in effect 5949, words 1697 against her, saying, "I did not find in your daughter virginity 1331" but this 428 is the virginity token of my daughter." And they shall spread 6566 the <u>bed covering</u> 8071 before the elders of the city.

18. And the elders of the city shall take the man and chastise 3256 him:

19. and they shall fine 6064 him a hundred shekels of silver, and give them to the father of the damsel, because the man has brought forth an evil name upon a virgin 1330 of Yisrael: and she shall be his wife; he may 3201 not 3808 send her away 7971 all his days.

20. But, if this thing is true *571*, and the tokens of virginity are not found for the damsel;

21. then they shall bring forth the damsel to the door of her father's house, and the men of the city shall stone *5619* her with stones *68* so that she dies. Because she has done folly *5039* in Yis'rael, to act as a harlot *2181* in her father's house. So you shall remove *1197* wickedness *7451* from among you.

22. If a man is found lying 7901 with a woman married 1166 to a husband 1167, then they shall both 8147 die, the man that lay with the woman, and the woman. So you shall remove wickedness from Yis'rael.

23. If a damsel, a virgin, is betrothed 781 to a man, and another man finds her in the city, and lies with her;

24. then you shall bring them both to the gate of that city, and you shall stone them with stones so that they die; the damsel because she did not $\underline{\text{cry out }} 6817$ in the city, and the man, because he has humbled 6031 another man's wife. So you shall remove wickedness from among you.

25. But if a man finds a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man seizes 2388 her, and lies with her: then only the man that lay with her shall die:

26. but to the damsel you shall do nothing; in the damsel is no sin 2399 to death 4194: because as when a man rises up against another, and murders 7523 him, even so is this matter:

27. because he found her in the field, and the betrothed damsel cried, and there was none to save 3467 her.

28. If a man finds a virgin damsel, that is not betrothed, and seizes her, and lies with her, and they are found;

29. then that man that lay with her shall give to the damsel's father fifty shekels of silver, and she shall be his wife, because he has humbled her, and he shall not send her away all his days.

CHAPTER 22 NOTES

Chapter 22 is loaded with serious rules for behavior. Verses 1-4 - It starts off with helping your racial kinsman with straying livestock, overburdened animals falling down, and in general "helping your neighbor". Verse 5 prohibits "cross-dressing", and in today's permissive society, full of sodomites, this is a major infraction. Verses 6 and 7 deal with birds' eggs, and chicks. If you take a mother bird, you wipe out a breeder. Soon you will have fewer birds. Also, not letting the mother see her young taken is merciful. Even a bird receives compassion from Yahweh. How much more so an adam? Verse 8 is about a safety rail for your flat roof, which they used as an open-air room in Yis'rael. Common sense and consideration for others is what is stressed here. Verses 9-11 prohibit the "mixing" of things, which goes back to Genesis 1:11,12; and Lev. 19:19. Verse 12 refers to a four cornered garment with tsitsith (tassels) on its corners. This is not a fashion suggestion, but a direct commandment to Yis'rael. The four cornered garment and tsitsith are a reminder of Yahweh's commandments to Yis'rael, as stated in Numbers 15:37-41. This commandment still applies to Yis'rael today. Just because the "jews" try to steal our birthright does not mean we should allow it. All true male Yis'raelites should wear this type of garment, and not only as a "prayer shawl". Every day wear. Verses 13-19 speaks of a man lying about his bride's virginity, and the penalty for those lies. He was stuck with her forever, with no divorce allowed. It was a standard custom, especially among European royalty, to present the wedding sheet to the bride's father. Kings even hung it out of their window for all to see, and to show consummation, which sealed the marriage. Morality was a major factor then, but not now. Virgins are somewhat hard to find these days. We are suffering consequences for this, as our family structure is disintegrating nationwide, as our children are taught unscriptural behavior in our "schools", and through TV and movies. Verses 20 and 21 gives the penalty death by stoning) if what the husband says is true. This would cut back on promiscuity if this were enforced today, wouldn't it? Verse 22 deals with an unfaithful wife, and the man she is caught with. Imagine if we enforced this one today? Society would be a lot different, would it not? Verses 23 and 24 deal with promiscuity again. There were serious penalties back then. Verse 25 deals death for a rapist, and innocence is declared for the victim in verses 26 and 27. Verses 28 and 29 force a man to marry, and forbids divorce from the maid he violates. Back then, when you took a virgin, you were instantly married, or had some stiff penalty levied upon you. No "fooling around" was allowed. Verse **30** in the KJV is actually verse l of Chapter 23.

Chapter 23

1. A man shall not take his father's wife, nor uncover *1540* his father's skirt *3651*. *Persons Excluded From the Congregation*

2. Shall not enter he that is wounded *6481* by crushing *1795* of the testicles, or has his penis *8212* cut off, into the congregation *6951* of Yahweh.

3. Shall not enter a mamzer 4464 into the congregation of Yahweh; even to the tenth 6224 generation 1755 shall he not enter the congregation of Yahweh.

4. Shall not enter an Ammoniy 5984 or Moabiy 4125 into the congregation of Yahweh; even to

the tenth generation they shall not enter the congregation of Yahweh until everlasting 5769,

5. over the matter *1697* that they did not meet *6923* you with bread *3899* and with water *4325* upon the way *1870*, when you came forth from Mits'rayim; and that they hired *7936* against you Bil'am *1109* son of Beor *1160* of Pethor *6604* of Aram-Nacharayim *763*, to curse *7045* you.

6. But would *14* not *3808* Yahweh Eloheycha listen *8085* to Bil'am; but turned *2015* Yahweh Eloheycha for you the curse into a blessing *1293*, for loved *157* you Yahweh Eloheycha.

7. You shall not seek 1875 their peace 7965 or prosperity 2896 all your days forever 5769.

8. You shall not abhor 8581 an Aromiy 726; for he is your racial kinsman 251: you shall not abhor a Mits'riy 4713, for you were a sojourner 1616 in his land.

9. The children that are begotten 3205 of them in the third 7992 generation shall enter the congregation of Yahweh. *Purity During War*

10. When goes forth the army 4264 against your hated enemies 341, keep 8104 from all things 1697 of evil 7451.

11. If there is among you any man that is not clean 2889 because of a <u>nocturnal emission</u> 7137 at night, then he shall go forth to outside the camp, he shall not come within the camp.

12. But it shall be when evening comes, he shall wash 7364 with water: and when the sun is down, he shall come into the camp.

13. You shall have a place outside the camp, where you shall go forth outside:

14. and you shall have a tool *3489* among your implements *240*; and it shall be when you sit down *3427* outside you shall dig *2658* with it, and you shall turn back and cover *3680* your excrement *6627*:

15. because Yahweh Eloheycha walks in the midst of your camp, to deliver you, and to give up your hated enemies before you; therefore your camp shall be set-apart *6918*; so that He sees no naked *6172* thing *1697*, and turn away from following you.

Various Laws

16. You shall not deliver 5462 to his master 113 a slave 5650 which has escaped 5337 from his master unto you.

17. He shall dwell with you, among you, in that place he shall choose in one of your gates, where it is best for him: you shall not oppress *3238* him.

18. There shall be no <u>cult prostitutes</u> 6948 from the daughters of Yis'rael, nor a <u>temple prostitute</u> 6945 from the sons of Yisrael.

19. You shall not bring the hire 868 of a harlot 2181, or the price 4242 of a dog 3611 into the House of Yahweh Eloheycha for any vow 5088: because both of these are an abomination 8441 to Yahweh Eloheycha.

20. You shall not lend with usury *5391* to your racial kinsman *251*; usury *5392* of money, usury of food, usury of any thing that is lent upon usury.

21. To a racial alien 5237 you may lend upon usury; but to your racial kinsman you shall not

lend upon usury; so that may bless you Yahweh Eloheycha in all that you put 4916 your hand to in the land that you go to possess.

22. When you shall vow 5087 a vow 5088 to Yahweh Eloheycha, you shall not delay 309 to pay 7999 it, because would surely require 1875/1875 it Yahweh Eloheycha from you; and it would be to you sin 2399.

23. But if you shall cease *2308* to vow, it shall be no sin to you.

24. That which has gone forth 4161 from your lips 8193 you shall keep 8104 and do 6213; a freewill offering 5071, according to what you have vowed to Yahweh Eloheycha, which you have spoken 1696 with your mouth 6310.

25. When you come into your neighbor's vineyard, then you may eat your fill of grapes for yourself; but you shall not put any in your vessel.

26. When you come into the <u>standing grain</u> 7054 of your neighbor, then you may pluck 6998 the ears of grain 4425 with your hand; but you shall not <u>lift up</u> 5130 a sickle 2770 to your neighbor's standing grain.

CHAPTER 23 NOTES

Chapter 23 is full of laws. Many are quite clear, but several need some explanation, mostly for newer students of Scripture, but not all.

Verse 1 – Lev. 18:8; Deut. 27:20;

Verse 2 in the KJV has "bastard", as if an illegitimate child, for 4464. In the Hebrew, it is mamzer, and means one of mixed race, a mongrel. This is shown in Strong's Exhaustive Concordance clearly. Only pureblood Yis'rael is Yis'rael. Any other bloodline disqualifies that person from being of Yis'rael. As a generation is usually about 40 years, ten generations would work out to be around 400 years for admittance to the congregation, IF no further mixing was done in that person's lineage. Also it says EVEN to the tenth generation, so even ten generations were not enough. They could NEVER enter the Congregation. Yisrael was built on being a congregation of Yahweh, and it was of utmost importance to heads of families that following generations were in that congregation. NO Yis'raeliy would want to marry a son or daughter to a racial alien, as their line would be excluded from the congregation. This forced any mixed breeds to marry other mixed breeds, and none of them were eligible to be in Yahweh's Congregation. Those calling themselves "jews" today are all of mixed blood somewhere along their lineage, and openly claim Esaw as a patriarch. He married daughters of Cheth, a Kenaaniy (Canaanite), and Edom is of mixed bloodline. They hated Yaaqob/Yis'rael then, and still hate pureblood Yis'rael today. Any congregation that has non-Yis'rael people in it is not a congregation of Yahweh, and should be avoided. Race-mixing is an abomination to Yahweh.

Verse 3-5 – Neh. 13:1,2;

Verse 3 - concerns Ammoniy and Moabiy (Ammonites and Moabites). This is where the Book of Ruth connects. Ruth was an Yis'raeliyth (Israelitess) living in the FORMER territory of Moab. She was not a racial Moabite. Boaz was a Prince of Yahudah, and for the aforementioned reasons would not have married a person of cursed seedline, as any children would forever be excluded from the Congregation. Down the line, Yahshua Messiah had Ruth and Boaz as ancestors. Yahweh would not manifest Himself in a cursed-seedline family. Yahshua was PERFECT, and the Christ-haters will use any lie they can to blemish His lineage. They are of their father Satan, and their father's work they do.

Verse 4 – Num. 22:1-6;

Verse 5 – Num. 23:7-24; 24:9;

Verse 7 is a complete mess in the KJV and others. They have continued to misuse the word Edomite

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/Edomiy 130 where it should be Aramean /Aromiy 726. Strong's Exhaustive Concordance shows under 726 that 130 is a scribal error for 726. Aram 758 was a son of Shem, the son of Noach, and Aramean comes from that, and Yis'rael is definitely blood kindred to Shem. As to the scribal error, when they switched from Paleo-Hebrew letters to the newer block form, they still had no Masoretic vowel points, and the letter D (daleth) and the letter R (resh) are similar in appearance in the block form. Any damage or smudging of the letters on the document being translated could have resulted in a switching of these letters. This one letter change also changes the context of that verse. Scripture backs up Aromiy instead of Edomiy, because it goes heavily against Edom. Esaw, called Edom, married daughters of Cheth (Heth - Hittites), and a Mitsriyth (female Egyptian), and his descendants were of cursed-seedline, and mixed bloodline. These mixed with other Kenaaniy Canaanites), and the cursed seed of Qayin (Cain). Esaw hated Yaaqob (Jacob), who was named Yis'rael by Yahweh, and his seedline still hates pureblooded Yis'rael today.

The following list of references is long, but you really need to look at all of them. In English, in other Bibles, the words used are Esau, Edom, and Edomite(s) for recognition purposes. In my accurized translation the words are as they are spelled in Hebrew.

Hebrews 12:16. This is quite a list of negatives about Edom.

Yahshua Messiah spoke Aramean. Parts of Ezra and Daniel are in Aramean. Aramean is very close to Hebrew. See 26:5 as to Yis'rael's Aramean forefathers. Terah, father of Abraham was of Aram. On and

on it goes. The continued use of a known error in these Bibles is due to the monetary influence of the descendants of Esaw today.

Verse 8 states 3 generations for children of mixed Aromiy and Mits'riy marriages. These were not of the chosen of the Exodus, but at that time period, before they mixed with non-adamics, they were of adamic bloodline. Today this is not so. All of that area is now of mixed bloodline, and we are not to marry with them anymore. Times, and racial demographics, have changed. Mits'rayim is Hebrew for Egypt, Mits'rayim was a son of Cham (Ham), and was not cursed like K'naan (Canaan), thus was of adamic seedline. No more. Gen. 10:22; Deut. 26:5.

[Special thanks to Clifton Emahiser for noting the scribal error in his Watchman's Teaching Letters]

Verses 10-15 deal with sanitary purity in a military camp.

Verse 11 – Lev. 15:16;

Verses 16,17 deal with an escaped slave, and fair treatment for him/her.

Verse 17 – Lev. 19:29;

Verses 18,19 deal with the pagan cult temple prostitutes, male and female. Sex orgies were part of pagan worship (fertility " gods"). A "dog" is a derogatory idiomatic term for a male sodomite prostitute, or other disgusting unclean people. Those nations that practiced these things were the ones Yahweh commanded to be utterly destroyed. We did not get the job done, and they plague us yet today.

Verses 19,20 - Ex. 22:25; Lev. 25:37; Deut. 15:7-11;

Verse 20,21 continue the prohibition of usury (interest) among Yis'rael. 251 can mean brother or kinsman, but ALWAYS has the meaning of blood kindred with it. 5237 is noch'riy in Hebrew, and means RACIAL alien/stranger. This is never translated properly in the "politically correct" Bibles, as it might offend some liberal "churches" with mixed congregations. They will be destroyed when Messiah returns. Read Revelations on this. Racial aliens were fair game for usury.

Verses 22-26 are quite clear, and need no comment.

Chapter 24

1. When a man has taken a wife, and married 1166 her, and it comes to pass that she finds no favor 2580 in his eyes, because he has found a matter 1697 of nakedness 6172 with her: then let him write her a scroll 5612 of severance 3748, and put it in her hand, and send her from his house.

2. And when she has gone forth from his house, she may go and be another 312 man's wife.

3. And if the latter *314* man hates *8130* her, and writes a scroll of severance, and puts it in her hand, and sends her from his house, or if the latter man dies, that took her as wife;

4. she is not able to return to her first 7223 husband which sent her away and he may not take her as wife, after that she is defiled 2930; for that is abomination 8441 before Yahweh: and you shall not <u>cause to sin</u> 2398 the land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you as an inheritance.

5. When a man takes a new 2319 wife, he may not go forth to <u>military service</u> 6635, and shall not pass over upon him any matter: he shall be blameless 5355 at his house one year, and shall cause to rejoice 8055 the wife that he has taken.

6. None may bind with a pledge 2254 the mill 7347 or upper millstone 7393, because a life 5315

he binds with a pledge.

7. If is found 4672 a man stealing 1589 a person 5315 of his kinsmen 251 of the children of Yis'rael, and <u>enslaves him</u> 6014 or sells 4376 him, shall be <u>put to death</u> 4191 that thief, and you shall remove wickedness from among you.

8. Guard 8104 yourselves from the blemish 5061 of <u>skin disease</u> 6883, and <u>guard carefully</u> 3966, and do all that teach 3384 you the priests, the Lewiyyim 3881. As I commanded them, you shall observe 8104 and do.

9. Remember *2142* that which did Yahweh Eloheycha to Mir'yam *4813* on the way, as you came forth from Mits'rayim.

10. When you lend your kinsman any *3972* loan *4859*, you shall not enter his house to take his pledge *5667*.

11. You shall stand outside, and the man to whom you lend shall bring forth to you the pledge outside.

12. And if the man is poor 6041, you shall not lie down to sleep in his pledge;

13. but return his pledge when the sun goes down, so that he may lie down to sleep in his own garment *8008*, and bless you. To you it shall be righteousness *6666* before Yahweh Eloheycha.

14. You shall not oppress 6231 a hired servant 7916 that is poor and needy, of your kinsmen, or of sojourners 1616 that are in your land within your gates.

15. Each day you shall give his wages 7939, neither shall the sun go down upon it; for he is poor, and supports 5375 himself with it: lest he cries against you to Yahweh, and it becomes sin to you.

16. Fathers shall not be put to death for children, nor shall children be put to death for fathers. Every man shall be put to death for his own sin.

17. You shall not wrest *5186* the rights *4191* of the sojourner, or the fatherless child; nor take a widow's clothing as a pledge:

18. but you shall remember that you were a slave in Mits'rayim, and Yahweh Eloheycha redeemed *6299* you from there: therefore I command you to do these things.

19. Because you reap 7114 your harvest 7105 in your field, and have forgotten 7911 a sheaf 6016 in the field, you shall not return to take it. It shall be for the sojourner, for the fatherless child, and for the widow, so that Yahweh Eloheycha may bless you in all the work of your hands.

20. When you beat 2251 your olive tree, you shall not go over the boughs 6286 again 310: it shall be for the sojourner, for the fatherless child, and for the widow.

21. When you gather the grapes *1219* of your vineyard *3754*, you shall not glean *5953* afterward, it shall be for the sojourner, for the fatherless child, and for the widow.

22. And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Mits'rayim: therefore I command you to do these things.

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CHAPTER 24 NOTES

All of this chapter is about the decent treatment of other people, and remembering the humble past of Yis'rael in the land of Mits'rayim. Common sense tells us to look after the welfare of our widows and orphans It also tells us to treat a man that we hire in a fair manner. Yahweh does not give us a heavy burden of law but a light one, based on love for others. Yahshua Messiah taught this truth to all.

Chapter 25

1. If there is a controversy 7379 between men, and they come to the place of judgement 4941, and are judged 8199; they shall justify 6663 the righteous 6662, and condemn 7561 the wicked 7563.

2. And it shall be, if the wicked is a son 1121 of smiting 5221, the judge shall cause him to <u>fall</u> <u>down</u> 5307, and to be smitten before him, sufficient 1767 for his fault 7564, by the number 4557 of blows.

3. Forty 705 smitings 5221, no more 3254, lest 6435 if more, and smite upon him many 7227 stripes 4347, then your kinsman might seem vile 7034 in your sight

4. You shall not muzzle 2629 the ox 7794 when it treads out 1758 grain.

5. If brothers live together, and one dies, and has no children, it shall not be that the wife of the dead shall go outside 2351 the family to a foreign 2114 man: the brother-in-law 2993 shall go in unto her, and take her as a wife, and perform the <u>duty of a brother-in-law</u> 2992 to her.

6. And it shall be, the firstborn that she bears shall be raised *6965* upon the name of the dead brother, that his name not be wiped out *4229* from Yis'rael.

7. If the man does not desire 2654 to take his brother's wife 2654, then let his brother's wife go up to the gate to the elders 2205, and say, "My brother-in-law refuses 3985 to raise up his brother's name in Yis'rael, he will not perform the duty of a brother-in-law."

8. Then shall call him the elders of the city, and speak to him: and if he stands, and says, "I do not desire to take her; "

9. then shall approach 5066 him his <u>sister-in-law</u> 2994 in the sight of the elders, and draw off 2502 his shoe 5275 from upon his foot, and spit 3417 in his face, and shall answer and say, "So

shall it be done to a man that will not build up 1129 his brother's house."

10. And his name shall be called in Yis'rael, "The house of the one of the drawn-off shoe."

11. When men struggle 5327 together one man with a kinsman, and the wife of the one draws near 7126 to rescue 5337 her husband from the hand of he that smites him, and she puts forth her hand and seizes 2388 him by the pudenda 4016:

12. then you shall <u>cut off</u> 7112 the palm of her hand 3709. Your eye shall not pity 2347.

13. There shall not be in your bag 3599 multiple stones 68/68, a great 1419 and a small 6996.

14. There shall not be in your house multiple ephas 374/374, a great and a small.

15. A stone perfect *8003* and just *6664* there shall be, an ephah perfect and just there shall be, so that long *748* shall be your days upon the land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you.

16. For an abomination 8441 to Yahweh Eloheycha are all that do these things, all that do unrighteously 5766.

17. Remember what did to you Amaleq 6002 on the way, when you came forth from Mits'rayim;

18. how they met you by the way, and attacked the rear *2179* of you, all that were feeble *2826* behind you, and you were faint *5889* and weary *3023*; and they did not fear *3372* Elohiym.

19. It shall be, when gives you rest *5117* Yahweh Eloheycha from all your hated enemies around you, in the land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you as an inheritance of possession, you shall wipe out *4229* the remembrance *2143* of Amaleq from under the sky. Do not forget *7911*!

3. And you shall go to the priest that shall be in those days, and say to him, "I declare this day to Yahweh Eloheycha for I have come to the land that swore Yahweh to our forefathers to give

us."

4. And the priest shall take the basket from your hand, and set it down before the altar of Yahweh Eloheycha.

5. And you shall speak and say before Yahweh Eloheycha, "An Arammiy 761 ready to perish 6 was my forefather. He went down to Mits'rayim, and sojourned 1481 there with a few 4962/4592, and became there a nation 1471, great, mighty, and populous 7227:

6. and did evil to 7489 us the Mits'riym 4713, and afflicted 6031 us, and put 5414 upon us harsh 7186 bondage 5656.

7. We cried 6817 to Yahweh Elohey of our forefathers, heard Yahweh our voice, and saw our affliction 6040, our misery 5999, and oppression 3906:

8. and brought us forth Yahweh from Mits'rayim with a mighty hand, and with an outstretched arm, and with great terrors *4172*, and with signs, and with wonders:

9. and He has brought us to this place, and given us this land, a land that flows with milk and honey.

10. And now, behold, I have brought the firstfruits of the ground *127*, which You have given me Yahweh. And you shall set it before Yahweh Eloheycha, and prostrate *7812* yourself before Yahweh Eloheycha.

11. And you shall rejoice in every good thing which gives you Yahweh Eloheycha, and to your household, you, and the Lewiy, and the sojourner among you.

12. And when you have made an end of tithing 6237 all the tithes 4643 of your increase 8393 the third year, the year of tithing, and have given it to the Lewiy, the sojourner, the fatherless child, and the widow, so they may eat within your gates, and be satisfied 7646:

13. Then you shall say before Yahweh Eloheycha, "I have removed these hallowed *6944* things from my house, and also have given them to the Lewiy, and the sojourner, the fatherless child, and the widow, according to all Your commandments *4687* that You commanded *6680*: I have not passed beyond Your commandments, and have not forgotten *7911* them:

14. I have not eaten from it in sorrow 205, nor have I removed from it for unclean 2931 use, nor given from it for the dead: I have listened to the voice of Yahweh Elohay 430, and done according to all You have commanded me.

15. Look down 8259 from Your Habitation 4583 of Holiness 6944, from the sky 8064, and bless Your people Yis'rael, and the land which You have given us, as You swore to our forefathers, a land that flows with milk and honey. "

16. This day Yahweh Eloheycha has commanded you to do these statutes 2706 and judgements 4941: you shall therefore keep and do them with all your heart, and with all your being 5315.

17. Yahweh you have said this day is to you Elohiym, and you will walk in His Ways, and will keep His statutes, and His commandments *4687*, and His judgements, and will listen to His voice:

18. and Yahweh has said 559 this day you will be His treasured 5459 people, as He spoke 1696 to you, and to keep all His commandments;

19. and will place 5414 you high 5945 above all the nations 1471 that He made, in praise 8416,

and name 8034, and glory 8597; so you may be a people Holy 6918 to Yahweh Eloheycha, as He has spoken.

3. and you shall write 3789 upon them all the words 1697 of this Torah 8451 when you have passed over, so that you may enter into the land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives you, a land that flows 2100 with milk 2461 and honey 1706, that spoke of Yahweh Elohey to your forefathers.

4. It shall be when you pass over the Yarden, you shall set up these stones, that I command you today, on Mount Eybal *5858*, and whitewash them with whitewash.

5. And you shall build there an altar to Yahweh Eloheycha, an altar of stones. You shall not wield 5130 upon them a tool of iron 1270.

6. With stones that are whole *8003* you shall build the altar of Yahweh Eloheycha: you shall <u>send up</u> *5927* upon it <u>burnt offerings</u> *5930* to Yahweh Eloheycha,

7. and you shall slaughter 2076 offerings of well-being 8002, and shall eat there, and rejoice 8055 before Yahweh Eloheycha.

8. And you shall write upon the stones all the words of this Torah declared 874 thoroughly 3190."

9. And spoke Mosheh and the priests of the Lewiyim to all Yis'rael, saying, "<u>Take heed</u> 5535, and listen, O Yis'rael; this day you have become the People of Yahweh Eloheycha.

10. You shall listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha, and do His commandments and His statutes, that I command you today."

[The Blessings at Mount Geriziym, and Curses at Mount Eybal]

11. And commanded Mosheh the people that day, saying,

12. These representatives shall stand to bless *1288* the people upon Mount Geriziym *1630*, when you have passed over the Yar'den; of Shimeon *8095*, and of Lewiy *3878*, and of Yahudah *3063*, and of Yissaschar *3488*, and of Yoseph *3130*, and of Binyamin *1144*:

13. And these representatives shall stand to curse 7045 upon Mount Eybal 5858; of Reuben 7205, Gad 1410, and of Asher 836, of Zebulun 2074, Dan 1835, and of Naph'taliy 5321.

14. And shall answer *6030* the Lewiyyim, and say to all men of Yis'rael with an uplifted *7311* voice,

15. "Cursed 779 be the man that makes 6213 a carved idol 6459 or cast idol 4541, an abomination 8441 to Yahweh, the work 4639 of the hands of the craftsman 2796, and sets it up 7760 in secrecy 5643." And answered all the people, and said "Amen 543."

16. "Cursed be he that dishonors 7034 his father or his mother. "And said all the people, "Amen."

17. "Cursed be he that moves *5253* the <u>boundary marker</u> *1366* of another man." And said all the people "Amen."

18. "Cursed be he that causes to go astray *7686* the blind *5787* from the path *1870*." And said all the people, "Amen. "

19. "Cursed be he that perverts *5186* justice *4941* of the sojourner, the fatherless child, and the widow." And said all the people, Amen."

20. "Cursed be he that lies 7901 sexually with the wife of his father; because he uncovers 1540 the skirt 3671 of his father." And said all the people, "Amen."

21. "Cursed be he that lies sexually with any beast *929*." And said all the people, "Amen."

22. "Cursed be he that lies sexually with his sister *269*, the daughter of his father, or the daughter of his mother." And said all the people, "Amen."

23. "Cursed be he that lies sexually with his mother-in-law 2859." And said all the people, "Amen."

24. "Cursed be he that smites to death *5221* another person secretly *5643*." And said all the people, "Amen."

25. "Cursed be he that takes a bribe 7810 to smite to death a person 5315 of innocent 5355 blood 1818." And said all the people, Amen."

26. "Cursed be he that does not confirm *6965* the words of this Torah *8451*, to do *6213* them." And said all the people, "Amen."

CHAPTER 27 NOTES

Chapter 27 is a repeat of Torah from Exodus (Shemoth), and Leviticus (Wayyiq'ra). This was needed, as these were a whole new generation of Yis'rael, and had not gone through the wilderness experience of their forefathers. They were to publicly display the Torah on the whitewashed rocks, for all to see. This was part of Yisrael being a set-apart people, different from the "people of the land", in other words, the Kenaaniy. Half the tribes were to be represented on Mount Geraziym, and the other half on Mount Eybal. 27 has all the curses from Mount Eybal. The blessings will follow in Chapter 28. Verses **20-23** are sexual laws. In particular, verse **21** has to do with bestiality. In those days, non-adamic people were called "beasts" in a derogatory manner. They were put on the level of draft animals. Yis'rael was not to breed with them, and it was a death penalty if you were caught. They were also shepherds, and perverted sex with sheep or goats also resulted in a death penalty if caught. Race-mixing is an abomination to Yahweh, and strictly punished back then. It abounds these days, as the entire

world is perverted and destined for destruction. Read 2 Thessalonians 1:6-10 for what happens when Yahshua Messiah returns.

Chapter 28

[Blessings For Obedience]

1. And it shall be, if you shall listen diligently to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha, to observe and do all His commandments that I command you today, that will set *5414* you Yahweh Eloheycha on high *5945* over all the nations of the land.

2. And shall come upon you all these blessings *1293*, and overtake *5381* you, because you listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha:

3. Blessed *1288* shall you be in the city *5892*, and blessed shall you be in the field *7704*.

4. Blessed shall be the fruit 6529 of your womb 990, and the fruit of your ground 127, and the fruit of your beasts 929, the increase 7698 of your oxen 504, and the flocks 6251 of your sheep 6629.

5. Blessed shall be your basket *2935* and your kneading trough *4863*.

6. Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed when you go forth.

7. Shall give Yahweh your hated enemies that rise up against you to be smitten 5062 before you:

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by one way they will go forth against you, and seven ways they shall flee 5127 before you.

8. Shall command Yahweh upon you the blessing in your storehouses *618*, and in all the works of your hands. Blessed shall be the land that Yahweh Eloheycha gives to you.

9. Shall establish *6965* you Yahweh as a people Holy to Him, as He has sworn *7650* to you, because you shall keep the commandments of Yahweh Eloheycha, and walk *1980* in His ways *1870*.

10. And shall see all the peoples of the land that by the Name of Yahweh you are called; and they shall be afraid *3372* of you.

11. And shall make abundant *3498* Yahweh prosperity *2896*, in the fruit of your womb, in the fruit of your beasts, in the fruit of the ground, on the ground that swore Yahweh to your forefathers to give you.

12. Shall open 6605 Yahweh to you His good 2896 storehouse 214, the sky 8064, to give rain 4306 to the land in its proper time 6256, and to bless all the work of your hands: and you shall lend 3867 to many nations, and you shall not borrow 3867.

13. And shall make you Yahweh the head 7218, and not the tail 2180; and you shall be above 4605 only 7535, and you shall not be beneath 4295; because you listen to the commandments of Yahweh Eloheycha that I command you today to keep and do.

14. And you shall not turn aside *5493* from any of the words that I command you today, to the right hand *3225*, or the left *8040*, to walk after other elohiym to serve them.

15. But it shall be, if *518* you will not listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha, to observe and do all the commandments and statutes that I command you today; then shall come upon you all these curses *7045*, and overtake *5381* you:

16. Cursed 779 shall you be in the city, and cursed shall you be in the field.

17. Cursed shall be your basket and kneading trough.

18. Cursed shall be the fruit of your womb, and the fruit of your ground, the increase of your cattle, and the flocks of your sheep.

19. Cursed shall you be when you come in, and cursed shall you be when you go forth.

20. Shall send Yahweh upon you cursing *3994*, discomfiture *4103*, and rebuke *4045*, in all you put your hand to do, until you are destroyed *8045*, and until you perish *6* quickly *4118*; from the presence of your wicked *7455* deeds *4611* by which you have forsaken *5800* Me.

21. Shall make to cleave *1692* Yahweh to you the pestilence *1698*, until you are consumed *3615* from upon the ground that you went there to possess.

22. Shall smite you Yahweh with a consumption 7829, and with a fever 6920, and with an inflammation 1816, and with a violent fever 2746, and with the sword 2719, and with blight 7711, and with mildew 3420; and they shall pursue 7291, you until you perish 6.

23. And shall become the sky that is over your head as bronze 5178, and the land that is underneath as iron 1270.

24. And shall make Yahweh the rain 4306 of your land powder 80 and dust 6083: from the sky

it shall come down upon you, until you are destroyed 8045.

25. Shall give you Yahweh to be smitten 5062 before your hated enemies: one way you shall go forth against them, and seven ways you shall flee 5127 before them, and shall become a terror 2189 to all the kingdoms of the land.

26. And shall be your carcasses *5038* food *3978* for all the birds *5775* of the sky, and the beasts of the land, and none shall terrify *2729* them.

27. Will smite you Yahweh with the boils 7822 of Mits'rayim, and with the hemorrhoids 2914, and with scabs 1618, and with the itch 2775, of which you are not able 3201 to be healed 7495.

28. Will smite you Yahweh with madness 7697, and blindness 5788, and confusion 8541 of mind 3824:

29. and you shall be groping 4959 at noonday 6672, as grope the blind 5787 in darkness 653, and shall not prosper 6743 in your ways: and shall be oppressed 6231 and robbed 1497 all your days, and none 369 shall save 3467 you.

30. A wife you shall betroth 781, and another man shall ravish 7693/7902 her: a house you shall build, and not dwell in it: a vineyard you shall plant 5193, and not eat the grapes of it 2490.

31. Your ox 7794 shall be slaughtered 2873 before your eyes, and you shall not eat of it: your ass 2543 shall be violently taken away 1497 from before you, and shall not be returned to you: your sheep 6629 given to your hated enemies, and none to save them.

32. Your sons and your daughters shall be given to another *312* people, and your eyes shall look, and long *3616* for them all the day: and no might *410* shall be in your hand.

33. The fruit of your ground and all your labors shall be eaten by a people that you do not know; and you shall only *7535* be oppressed *6231* and crushed *7533* all the days,

34. so you will become insane *7696* from the sights *4758* that your eyes shall see.

35. Shall smite you Yahweh in the knees *1290*, and in the legs *7785*, with harmful *7451* boils *7822*, that are not able to be healed, from the sole *3709* of your feet to the <u>top of your head</u> *6936*.

36. Shall bring Yahweh you, and your king that you shall set 6965 over you, to a nation 1471 that you have not known, you, nor your forefathers; and you shall serve 5647 there other 312 elohiym 430, of wood 6086 and stone 68.

37. And you shall become an astonishment *8047*, a proverb *4912*, and a taunt *8148*, among all the peoples where shall lead *5090* you Yahweh there.

38. Much seed shall go forth to your fields, but little *4592* shall you gather *622*; for the locust *697* shall consume *2628* it.

39. Vineyards *3754* you shall plant *5193*, and tend *5647* them, but the wine *3196* you shall not drink *8354*, nor gather grapes *103*; because the vine weevils *8438* shall eat them.

40. Olive trees 2132 you shall have in all your territory 1366, but with the oil 8081 you shall not anoint 5480 yourself, because shall drop off 5394 the olive trees their fruit.

41. Sons and daughters you shall beget, but they shall not be yours; for they shall go into captivity 7628.

42. All your trees and fruit of your ground shall possess the locust 6767.

43. The alien sojourner *1616* within you *7130* shall rise up above you very high *4605/4605*; and you shall come down very low *4295/4295*.

44. He shall lend to you *3867*, and you shall not lend to him: he shall be the head *7218*, and you shall be the tail *2180*.

45. Shall come upon you all these curses 7045, and shall pursue 7291 you, and overtake 5381 you, until you are destroyed 8045; because you do not listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha, to keep His commandments, and His statutes, that He commanded you:

46. And they shall be upon you for a sign 226 and a wonder 4159, upon your seedline 2233 until everlasting 5769,

47. because that you do not serve Yahweh Eloheycha with rejoicing *8057*, with goodness *2898* of heart *3824*, from the abundance *7230* of all *3605*.

48. You shall serve your hated enemies which shall send Yahweh, in hunger 7458, and in thirst 6772, and in nakedness 5903, and in need 2640 of all given things: a yoke 5923 of iron 1270 will be upon your neck 6677 until He destroys you.

49. Shall bring Yahweh upon you a nation from far off 7350, from the end 7097 of the land, that flies swiftly 1675 as the eagle 5404; a nation of which you cannot understand 8085 their language 3956;

50. a nation of fierce *5794* countenance *6440*, that does not lift up the person of the elder *2205*, and shows the youth *5288* no mercy *2603*,

51. and shall eat the fruit of your beasts, and the fruit of your ground, until you are destroyed: which shall not leave 7604 you corn 1715, new wine 8492, or fresh oil 3323, the increase of your cattle, or the flocks of your sheep, until he has destroyed you.

52. They shall besiege 6887 you in all your gates, until come down your walls 2346, high 1364 and fortified 1219, that you trusted 982, throughout all your land: and they shall besiege you in all your gates throughout all your land, that gave Yahweh Eloheycha to you.

53. And you shall eat the fruit of your womb, the flesh of your sons and your daughters, that gave you Yahweh Eloheycha, in the siege *4692*, and in the straitness *4689*, by which distress *6693* you your hated enemies.

54. The man that is tender 7390, and very 3966 dainty 6028, his eye shall be evil 7489 toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom 2436, and toward the remnant 3499 of his children that are left 3498:

55. so that he will not give to any of them from the flesh of his children whom he shall eat: because he has nothing left 7604 in the siege, and in the straitness, by which distress you your hated enemies in all your gates.

56. The tender and dainty woman which would not pass over the sole of her foot upon the ground for daintiness and from tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward her husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter,

57. and toward her young one *7988* that comes forth from between her feet, and toward her children that she will bear: because she shall eat them for need of everything secretly *5643*, in

the siege and the straitness, by which distress you your hated enemies in your gates.

58. If you do not observe 8104 and do 6213 all the words of this Torah that are written in this scroll 5612, that you fear 3372 this Name 8034 that is honored 3513 and <u>held in awe</u> 3372, YAHWEH Eloheycha;

59. will make extraordinary *6381* Yahweh your plagues *4347*, and the plagues of your seedline plagues of greatness *1419*, and long duration *539* harmful *7451* sicknesses *4064*, of long duration.

60. He shall return upon you all the sicknesses 4064 of Mits'rayim, that you feared 3025 before, and they shall cleave 1692 to you.

61. Also every sickness, and every plague, that are not written in this scroll of Torah, will bring up Yahweh upon you, until you are destroyed.

62. And you shall be left few 4592 in number 4962, instead of being as the stars 3556 of the sky for multitude 7230, because you did not listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha.

63. And it shall be, as rejoiced 7797 Yahweh over <u>doing you good</u> 3190, and multiplying 7235 you; so will rejoice Yahweh over destroying 6 you, and exterminating 8045 you; and shall uproot 5255 you from upon the soil that you go there to possess.

64. And shall scatter *6327* you Yahweh among all the peoples, from one end of the land to the other end of the land; and you shall serve there other elohiym, that you did not know, you, or your forefathers, wood and stone.

65. Among these nations you will find no rest 7280, nor shall there be a <u>resting place</u> 4494 for the sole of your foot, but shall give Yahweh to you a heart 3820 of quaking 7268, and failing 3631 eyes, and a languishing 1671 of being 5315.

66. And shall be your life 2416 <u>hung up</u> 8511 in front 5048 of you; and you shall fear 6342 night and day, and have no trust 539 in your life.

67. In the morning you shall say, "If only it were evening 6153 !" And at evening you shall say, "If only it were morning *1242*!" From the fear in your heart that you fear, and for the sights of your eyes that you see.

68. And shall return you Yahweh to Mits'rayim with ships *591*, by the way that I spoke of to you, and you shall no more again see it: and you shall be sold *4376* there to your hated enemies for slaves *5650* and slave girls *8198*, and no man shall acquire *7069* you.

69. And these are the Words of the Covenant, which commanded Yahweh to Mosheh to make with the children of Yis'rael in the land of Moab, besides the Covenant that He made with them in Choreb 2722.

Chapter 29

1. And called Mosheh to all Yis'rael, and said to them: "You have seen all that did Yahweh in your sight in the land of Mits'rayim to Par'oh 6547, and to all his servants, and to all his land;

2. and the great tests 4531 that saw your eyes, the signs 226, and those great wonders 4159:

3. and has not given to you Yahweh a mind *3820* to know, and eyes to see, and ears to hear, until this day?

4. I have led 1980 you forty years in the wilderness: and your clothing 8008 has not grown old 1086 upon you, and your shoes 5275 have not grown old upon your feet;

5. and bread 3899 you have not eaten, and wine 3196 or <u>strong drink</u> 7941 you have not drunk 8354: so that you might know I am Yahweh Eloheychem."

6. And when you came into this place, Siychon the king of Chesh'bon and Og the king of Bashan met us for battle, and we smote them:

7. and we took their land, and gave it for an inheritance to the Rubeniy 7206 and the Gadiy 1425, and to the half tribe of the Menashshiy 4519.

8. Therefore keep the Words of this Covenant, and do them, so that you may prosper *7919* in all you do.

9. You stand this day, all of you, before Yahweh Eloheychem; your chiefs *7218* of your tribes *7626*, your elders *2205*, and your officers *7860*, all the men of Yis'rael,

10. and your little ones 2945, your wives, and the alien sojourner 1616 that is within your camp, from the hewer 2404 of your wood, to the drawer 7579 of your water:

11. that you pass over into the Covenant of Yahweh Eloheycha, into the oath *423* that Yahweh Eloheycha makes with you this day:

12. so that He may establish *6965* you today as a people, and to you He shall be Elohiym, as He spoke to you, as that He swore to your forefathers, to Ab'raham, to Yits'chaq, and to Yaaqob.

13. Nor with you alone 905 do I make this Covenant, and this oath;

14. but with those that exist 3426 here 6311 with us to stand today before Yahweh Eloheynu, and with those that are not here with us today.

15. Because you know that we have dwelled in the land of Mits'rayim, and that we passed through the nations that you passed through;

16. and you have seen their abominations *8251*, and their idols *1544*, wood and stone, silver and gold, that were among them:

17. lest there exist with you a man, or a woman, or a clan, or a tribe, that their hearts turn away today from Yahweh Eloheynu, to walk after and serve the elohey of these nations, lest there exist among you a root *8328* that bears *6509* gall *7219* and wormwood *3939*.

18. And it might be, when he hears the words of these curses 423, that he blesses 1288 himself in his heart, saying, "Peace shall be with me, though in the stubbornness 8307 of my mind I walk, that I may snatch away 5595 the watered 7302 and the thirsty ground 6774."

19. Yahweh will not spare 5545 him, because then shall smoke 6225 the anger 639 of Yahweh and His jealousy 7068 against that man, and shall lie 7257 upon him all the curses that are written in this scroll, and shall <u>blot out</u> 4229 Yahweh his name from under the sky.

20. And shall separate 914 him Yahweh for harm 7451 from all the tribes of Yis'rael, according to all the curses of the Covenant that are written in this scroll of the Torah 8451.

21. Shall say the generation *1755* of children that shall rise up after you, and the <u>racial alien</u> *5237* that comes from a land far away, and sees the plagues of that land, and the sicknesses that has made Yahweh there;

22. "Sulfur *1614*, and salt *4417*, and burning *8316*, is the whole land, and it is not sown *2232*, and does not produce *6779*, nor comes up any grass *6212*, like the overthrow *4114* of Sedom *5467*, and Amorah *6017*, and Ad'mah *126*, and Tseboyim *6636*, that overthrew *2015* Yahweh in His anger *639* and rage *2534*. "

23. Shall say all the nations, "Upon what grounds has Yahweh done this to this land? Why the heat *2750* of this great anger?"

24. And shall say men, "Over that they forsook the Covenant of Yahweh Elohey of their forefathers, that He made with them when He brought them forth from the land of Mits'rayim:

25. and they went and served other elohiym, and prostrated before them, elohiym that they did not know, and had no portion *2505* in:

26. and was kindled *2734* the anger Of Yahweh upon this land, to bring upon it all the curses *7045* that are written in this scroll:

27. and rooted them out *5428* Yahweh from upon the soil *127* in anger, and rage *2534*, and in great wrath *7110*, and cast them *7993* into another land, as this day: "

28. The hidden *5641* things are Yahweh Eloheynu's: but the revealed *1540* things are ours, and our children's until everlasting, so that we may do all the words of this Torah.

CHAPTER 29 NOTES

In verses **12-15**, Mosheh is speaking only of Yisrael as being part of the Covenant. The ger *1616* if non-Yisraeliy, are there only as witnesses.

Verse **13** makes it clear that only those descended from Abraham, Yitschaq, and Yaaqob were part of the Covenant Yisrael is to be a set-apart people.

Chapter 30

1. It shall be, when come upon you all these things, the blessing and the curse that I have set before you, and you shall call them to mind in all the nations, where has banished *5080* you Yahweh Eloheycha there,

2. and you shall return to Yahweh Eloheycha, and shall listen to His voice as to all that I command you today, you, and your children, with all your heart, and all your inner being;

3. then Yahweh Eloheycha shall return you from your captivity *7622*, and have compassion *7355*, and return and gather *6908* you from all the peoples where scattered *6327* you Yahweh Eloheycha there.

4. If you have been driven out *5080* to outermost *7097* parts of the sky, from there shall gather you Yahweh Eloheycha, and from there He will fetch *3947* you:

5. and will bring you Yahweh Eloheycha to the land that possessed your forefathers, and you shall possess it; and He will do you good *3190*, and multiply *7235* you more than your forefathers.

6. And will circumcise 4135 Yahweh Eloheycha your heart 3824, and the hearts of your seedline 2233, to love 157 Yahweh Eloheycha with all your heart, and all your inner being, so that you may live 2416.

7. And will put Yahweh Eloheycha all these curses upon your hated enemies, and upon those that <u>hate you</u> 8130, and that persecuted 7291 you.

8. And you shall return, and listen to the voice of Yahweh, and do all His commandments that I command you today.

9. And will make you plenteous *3498* Yahweh Eloheycha in every work *4639* of your hands, in the fruit of your womb *990*, and in the fruit of your beasts *929*, and in the fruit of you soil *127*, for good *2896*: for shall return Yahweh Eloheycha to rejoice *7797* over you for good, as He rejoiced over your forefathers:

10. for you shall listen to the voice of Yahweh Eloheycha, to keep His commandments, and His statutes written in this scroll of the Torah, for you shall return to Yahweh Eloheycha with all your mind, and all your <u>inner being 5315</u>.

11. because this commandment that I command you today, is not too difficult *6381* for you, neither is it <u>far off</u> *7350*.

12. It is not in the sky, so you say, "Who shall go up for us to the sky, and take it for us so we may hear, and do it? "

13. Neither is it beyond *5676* the sea, so you say, "Who shall pass over to beyond the sea for us, and take it for us, that we may hear it, and do it? "

14. But very near to you is the Word, in your mouth, and in your mind, to do it.

15. See, I have set before you today life 2416 and goodness 2896, or death 4194 and evil 7451;

16. in that I command you today to love *157* Yahweh Eloheycha, and to walk *1980* in His Way *1870*, and to keep His commandments, and statutes, and judgements, so you may live *2421* and multiply *7235*: and shall bless you Yahweh Eloheycha in the land that you go there to possess.

17. But if turns away your heart, and you do not listen, and are <u>thrust away</u> 5080, and prostrate to other elohiym, and serve them;

18. I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish 6/6, and shall not lengthen 748 your days upon the soil, that you pass over the Yarden to go there to possess.

19. I call to witness *5749* against you today the sky and the land, that I life and death I have set before you, blessings and curses: so choose *977* life, so that may live you and your seedline:

20. and love Yahweh Eloheycha, and listen to His voice, and cleave *1692* to Him, for He is your life, and the length *753* of your days: that you may dwell upon the soil that swore Yahweh to your forefathers, to Ab'raham, to Yits'chaq, and to Yaaqob, to give to them.

References Chapter 30

Chapter 31

1. And went Mosheh and spoke all these words to all Yis'rael;

2. and said to them,"I am a hundred and twenty years old today; and I am not able anymore to go forth and come in: and Yahweh has said to me that I may not pass over this Yarden River.

3. Yahweh Eloheycha will pass over before you and He shall destroy these nations before you and dispossess them. Yahshua *3091*, he shall pass over before you, as has spoken Yahweh.

4. And shall do Yahweh to them that which He did to Siychon and Og, kings of the Emoriy, and to their land that He destroyed.

5. And shall give them up Yahweh before you, to do to them all the commandments that I commanded you.

6. Be strong 2388 and courageous 553, and do not fear 3372, nor be afraid 6206 of their presence, for Yahweh Eloheycha, He walks with you; and will not abandon 7503 you, nor forsake 5800 you. "

7. And called Mosheh to Yahshua, and said to him in the sight of all Yis'rael, "Be strong and courageous, for you must go with these people to the land that swore Yahweh to our forefathers to give them, and you shall give it as an inheritance 5157 to them.

8. And Yahweh, He will walk before you, He will be with you, and will not abandon or forsake you, do not fear, nor be dismayed *2865*."

9. And wrote Mosheh this Torah, and gave it to the priests of the sons of Lewiy, which carried the Ark of the Covenant of Yahweh, and to all the elders of Yis'rael.

10. And commanded Mosheh to them, saying, "At the end 7093 of seven years, in the appointed 4150 year 8141 of release 8059, at the Feast 2282 of Booths 5521,

11. when comes all Yis'rael to appear before Yahweh Eloheycha in the place that He shall choose, you shall <u>read aloud</u> 7121 this Torah <u>in front of</u> 5048 all Yis'rael in their hearing 241.

12. Assemble *6950* the people, the men, and the women, and the little ones, and the sojourner that is within your gates, so that they may learn *3925*, and fear *3372* Yahweh Eloheychem, and observe and do all the words of this Torah;

13. and their children, that have not known, may hear, and learn to fear Yahweh Eloheychem, all the days that you live upon the soil that you pass over the Yar'den River there to possess.

14. And said Yahweh to Mosheh, "Behold, approaches your day to die: call Yahshua, and present 3320 yourselves at the Tent of Meeting, so I may command him." And went Mosheh and Yahshua, and presented themselves in the Tent of Meeting.

15. And appeared Yahweh in the Tent in a pillar *5982* of cloud *6051*, and stood the pillar of cloud at the door of the Tent.

16. And said Yahweh to Mosheh, "Behold, you shall lie down to sleep 7901 with your forefathers; and shall rise up this people, and go whoring 2181 after elohey 430 of racial aliens 5236 of the land where they go among them, and will forsake 5800 Me, and break 6565 My Covenant that I made with them.

17. And shall be kindled 2734 My anger 639 that day, and I will forsake them, and will hide 5641 My face from them, and they shall be devoured, and shall find them many evils and troubles 6869; and they shall say in that day, 'Is this not upon us because Elohay 430 is not among us, and have found us these evils?'

18. And I shall surely hide My face that day over all the evils that they have done, because they have turned 6437 to other elohiym.

19. Now write you this song 7892, and teach it to the children of Yis'rael: and put 7760 it in their mouths, so that shall be this song a witness 5707 against the children of Yis'rael.

20. Because when I brought them into their land 127 that I swore to their forefathers, that flows 2100 with milk 2461 and honey 1706; and they have eaten, and are satisfied 7646, and grown fat 1878; they will turn to other elohiym, and serve them, and reject 5006 Me, and break My Covenant.

21. And it shall be, when find them many evils and troubles, shall answer them this song before them as a witness; for it shall not be forgotten 7911 from the mouths of their seedline: for I know their plans 3336 that they make, this day, before 2962 I bring them to the land that I swore."

22. So wrote Mosheh this song that day, and taught it to the children of Yisrael.

23. And He commanded Yahshua son of Nun, saying, "Be strong and courageous; because you shall bring the children of Yis'rael into the land that I swore to them: and I will be with you."

24. And it was when Mosheh made an end of writing the Words of this Torah upon a scroll, until they were completed *8552*,

25. that commanded Mosheh the Lewiyyim, which carried the Ark of the Covenant of Yahweh, saying,

26. "Take this scroll of the Torah, and put it in the side *6654* of the Ark of the Covenant of Yahweh Eloheychem, and it shall be there for a witness against you,

27. because I know your rebellion 4805, and your hard 7186 neck 6203: behold, while I am yet

5750 alive with you today, rebellious *4784* you have been against Yahweh; and how much more *637* after my death?

28. Assemble to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, so I may speak in their ears these words, and call as witness *5749* against them the sky and the land.

29. For I know after my death you will be <u>utterly corrupt</u> 7843/7843, and turn aside from the way that I commanded you; and will befall 7122 you evil in the latter 319 days, because you will do evil in the eyes of Yahweh, to <u>provoke Him to anger</u> 3707 through the works 4639 of your hands.

30. And spoke Mosheh in the ears of all the assembly of Yis'rael the words of this song, until it was completed *8552*.

Chapter 32

[This chapter is The Song of Mosheh. It is an actual song in the Hebrew, and is quite complex in its construction.]

1. "Give ear 238, O skies, to these words 1697; and hear, O land, the speech 561 of my mouth!

2. Shall drop 6201 as the rain 4306 my teaching 3948, shall distill 5140 as the dew 2919 my speech 565, as the raindrops 8164 upon the grass 1877, and as the rain showers 7241 upon the herbage 6212.

3. Because the Name of Yahweh I will proclaim *7121*, and ascribe *3051* magnificence *1433* to Eloheynu *430*.

4. The Rock 6697! Perfect 8549 is His work 6467: because all His ways are just 4941: an El 410 of truth 530 without iniquity 5766, just 6662 and upright 3477 is He.

5. They have <u>dealt corruptly</u> 7843, not of His children is their blemish 3971 a generation 1755 that is twisted 6141 and tortuous 6618.

6. To Yahweh do you recompense *1580* thus *2063*, O people foolish *5036* and without wisdom *2450*? Is He not your Father that acquired *7069* you, and He who made *6213* you, and established *3559* you?

7. Remember the days of old, and consider the years of <u>many generations</u> *1755/1755*: ask *7592* your father, and he will tell you; your elders, and they will speak to you.

8. When divided to their inheritance 5157 Elyon 5945 the nations 1471, and separated 6504 the sons of Adam 121, He set up 5324 the borders 1366 of the people by the number 4557 of the children of Yis'rael.

9. Because the portion 2506 of Yahweh is His people, Yaaqob 3290 is the lot 2256 of His inheritance 5159.

10. He found 4672 him in the land of wilderness 4057, in the howling 3214 waste 8414 of a wilderness 3452; He surrounded 5437 him, He instructed 995 him, He guarded 5341 him as the "apple" 6380 of His eye.

11. As an eagle 5404 sip 5782 her nest 7064, over her young 1469 she hovers 7363, spreading abroad 6566 her wings 3671, she takes them, and bears 5375 them on her wings 84.

12. Assemble *6950* the people, the men, and the women, and the little ones, and the sojourner that is within your gates, so that they may learn *3925*, and fear *3372* Yahweh Eloheychem, and observe and do all the words of this Torah;

13. He made him ride 7392 upon the <u>high places</u> 1116 of the land, so that he might eat of the crops 8570 of the fields; and made him to suck 3243 honey 1706 from the rock 5553, and olive oil from the flinty rock 2496;

14. Butter 2529 of cattle 1241, and milk 2461 of sheep 6629, with fat 2459 of lambs 3733, and rams 352 of the sons of the flock of Bashan 1316, and goats 6260, with the fat of the kidneys 3629 of wheat 2406; and of the blood 1818 of the grape 6025 you drank 8354 the wine 2561.

15. But grew fat 8080 Yeshurun 3484, and kicked 1163: you are grown fat, you are grown thick 5666, you are obese 3780; then he forsook 5203 Eloah 433 which made him, and disdained 5034 the Rock of his salvation 3444.

16. They provoked Him to jealousy *7065* with foreign *2114* elohiym with abominations *8441* they provoked Him to anger *3707*.

17. They slaughtered 2076 to demons 7700, not to Eloah; to elohiym they did not know, to <u>new ones</u> 2319 that came from nearby 7138, that your forefathers had no acquaintance 8175 with.

18. Of the Rock that begot you, you are neglectful 7876, and have forgotten 7911 El 410 that formed 2342 you.

19. And when saw Yahweh, He contemned *5006* them, because of the vexation 3708 of His sons and daughters.

20. And He said, "I will hide *5641* My face from them, and I will see what their end *319* shall be: because they are a perverse *8419* generation; children of no faithfulness *529*.

21. They have provoked Me to <u>jealous anger</u> 7065 with that which is no 3808 el 410; they have <u>provoked Me to anger</u> 3707 with their vanities 1892: so I shall provoke them to jealous anger with those which are not a people, and with a foolish 5036 nation I shall vex 3707 them.

22. Because a fire is kindled 6919 in My anger, and shall burn 3344 unto the lowest parts 8482 of Sheol 7585, and shall consume the land with its crops 2981, and <u>set afire</u> 3857 the foundations 4146 of the mountains.

23. I will add 5595 upon them calamities 7451; My arrows 2671 I will exhaust 3615 on them.

24. They shall be wasted 4198 with hunger 7458, and eaten up 3898 with the fire-bolt 7565, and with bitter 4815 destruction 6986: the teeth 8127 of beasts 929 I will send upon them,

with the poison 2534 of crawlers 2119 of the dust 6083.

25. From outside 2351 shall <u>make childless</u> 7921 the sword 2719, and from within 2315 the terror 367, both 1571 the young man 970, and the maiden 1330, the suckling child 3423 with 1571 the man 376 of gray hair 7872.

26. I said, I would <u>cleave them in pieces</u> 6284, I would make the memory 2143 of them to cease 7673 from among mortals 582:

27. except 3884 the anger 3708 of their hated enemy I feared 1481, lest their adversaries 6862 should misconstrue 5234 it, lest they should say, 'Our hand is high 7311, and Yahweh has not wrought 6466 all of this.'

28. Because they are a nation which has lost 6 its counsel 6098, and not with them is understanding 8394.

29. <u>Oh that</u> 3863 they were wise 2449, they understood 7919 this, and would consider 995 their latter end 319!

30. How 349 should pursue 7291 one 259 a thousand 505, and two 8147 <u>put to flight</u> 5127 a multitude 7233, if not their rock had sold 4376 them, and Yahweh had delivered them up 5462?

31. Because not as our Rock is their rock, even our hated enemies being judges 6414.

32. Because from the vine 1612 of Sedom 5467 is their vine, and from the fields 7709 of Amora 6017: their grapes 6025 are grapes of gall 7219, their clusters 811 a <u>bitter thing</u> 4846.

33. Venom 2534 of serpents 8577 is their wine 3196, and the venom 7219 of cobras 6620 is cruel 393.

34. Is this not laid in store 3647 with Me, and sealed up 2856 among My treasures 214?

35. To Me belongs vengeance 5359, and recompense 8005; in time 6256 shall slip 4131 their foot 7272: because is near 7138 the day of their calamity 343, and shall hasten 2363 the things that shall come 6264."

36. Because shall judge 1777 Yahweh His people, and upon His servants have compassion 5162, for He sees because has gone 235 their power 3027, and has ceased 657 the imprisonment 6113, and they are freed 5800.

37. And He shall say, "Where 335 are their eloheymo 430, their rock in whom they sought refuge 2620,

38. that ate the fat of their slaughterings 2077, and drank the wine of their drink offerings? Let them rise up and help 5826 you, and be your protection 5643.

39. See now that I, I am He, and no elohiym beside 5978 Me: I kill 4191 and make alive 2421; I smite 4272, and I heal 7495: none can rescue 5337 from My hand.

40. Because I lift up to the sky My hand, and say, 'As I live forever,

41. if I whet 8150 My flashing 1300 sword 2719, and take hold 270 of judgement 4941 My hand; I will repay 7725 vengeance 5359 to My adversaries 6862, and those who hate 8130

Me I will recompense 7999.

42. I will make drunken 7937 My arrows 2671 with blood 1818, and My sword shall devour flesh 1320; from the blood of the slain 2491, and of the captives 7633, from the heads 7218 of the leaders 6546 of the hated enemy.' "

43. Shout for joy 7442, O you Yis'rael nations, His people: because the blood of His servants He will avenge, and vengeance He will return to His adversaries, and will cover 3722 His land 127 and people.

[End of Song of Mosheh]

44. And came Mosheh and spoke all the words of this song in the ears of the people, he and Hoshea *1954* son of Nun *5126*.

45. And made an end Mosheh of speaking all these words to all Yis'rael:

46. And he said to them, "Set upon your hearts all these words that I testify *5749* to you today, that you shall command your children to keep and do, all the words of this Torah.

47. Because it is not a matter of vanity *7386* for you, for it is your life: and by this matter you shall lengthen *748* your days upon the soil *127*, that you pass over the Yarden here to possess." *[Yahweh prepares Mosheh for death]*

48. And spoke Yahweh to Mosheh that selfsame 6106 day, saying,

49. "Go up into this mount Abariym 5682, Mount Nebo 5015, that is in the land of Moab, that is before Yerecho 3405; and look upon the land of Kenaan, that I give to the children of Yis'rael as a possession 272:

50. and die on the mountain that you go up there, and be gathered 622 to your people; as died Aharon your brother in Mount Hor, and was gathered to his people.

51. Over that you trespassed 4603 against Me among the children of Yis'rael at the waters of Meribath-Qadesh 4809/6946, in the wilderness of Tsin 6790; because you did not sanctify 6942 Me in the midst of the children of Yis'rael.

52. Yet you shall see the land, but there you shall not go, to the land that I give to the children of Yis'rael.

Chapter 33

1. And this is the blessing that blessed Mosheh the man of Elohiym the children of Yis'rael before his death.

2. And he said, "Yahweh came from Siynay 5514, and <u>rose up</u> 2224 from Seiyr 8165 to them; He <u>shined forth</u> 3313 from Mount Paran 6290, and arrived 857 with myriads 7233 of sacredness 6944: from His right hand a fiery 784 law 1881 for them.

3. Yea 637, He cherished 2245 the people; all His <u>sacred ones</u> 6918 in His hand: they assembled 8497 at His feet, they carry away His words 1703.

4. Torah commanded to us Mosheh. The inheritance 4181 of the assembly 6952 of Yaaqob.

5. He was in Yeshurun *3484* King *4428*, when gathered the heads of the people together the tribes of Yis'rael.

6. Let live Reuben, and not die, and be few in number."

7. And this of Yahudah: he said, "Hear Yahweh, the voice of Yahudah, and to his people bring him: his be sufficient *7227* for him; and a help *5828* from his adversaries *6862* be."

8. And of Lewiy he said, "Your Tummeycha *8550* and Ureycha *224* be with your holy *2623* men, whom you tested *5254* at Massah *4532*, with whom you strove *7378* at the waters of Meriybah *4809*;

9. who said to his father and to his mother, "I have not seen him;" neither did he acknowledge *5234* his brothers, and his children he did not know: because they have observed Your Word, and kept Your Covenant.

10. They shall teach Your judgements to Yaaqob, and your Torah to Yis'rael. They shall put Your incense before Your nose, and a burnt offering *3632* upon Your altar.

11. Bless Yahweh, his wealth 2428, and accept 7521 the work of his hands: smite through 4272 the loins 4975 of those who rise against him, and those that hate him from rising again."

12. Of Binyamin he said, "The beloved *3039* of Yahweh shall dwell *7931* in safety *983* by Him: and covered *2653* over all the day, and between *996* His shoulders *3802* he shall dwell."

13. And of Yoseph he said, "Blessed of Yahweh be his land, from the <u>choice things</u> 4022 of the sky, for the dew 2919, and for the deep 8415 that lies 7257 beneath 8478,

14. and for the precious 4022 crops 8393 from the sun 8121, and the choice things put forth 1645 from the moon 3391,

15. and the chief things 7218 of the ancient 6924 mountains 2022, and the choice things of the everlasting 5769 hills 1389.

16. And for the choice things of the land and its fullness 4393, and the good will 7522 of He that dwelled 7931 in the <u>burning bush</u> 5572: let come upon the head 7218 of Yoseph, and upon the top of the head 6936 of those consecrated 5139 from his brothers.

17. As the firstborn 1060 of a bullock 7794 is his glory 1926, and the horns 7161 of a wild bull

7214 as his horns: with them the people he will push 5055 together 3162 to the ends 657 of the land: and they are the multitude 7233 of Eph'rayim, and they are the thousands 505 of Menashsheh."

18. And of Zebulun he said, "Rejoice *8055*, Zebulun, in your going forth; and Yissaschar in your tents.

19. The people to the mountain they shall call; there they shall slaughter sacrifices of righteousness: because the abundance 8228 of the seas they shall suck 3243, and of covered treasures 8226 hidden 2934 in the sand 2344."

20. And of Gad, he said, "Blessed be he that enlarges 7337 Gad: he dwells as a lion 3833, and tears in pieces 2963 the arm 2220 with the crown of the head 6936.

21. And he saw 7200 the first 7225 *part for himself*, for there, in a portion 2513 of a lawgiver 2710 he was seated 5603; and he came 857 with the heads of the people, the righteousness 6666 of Yahweh he did, and His judgements 4941 with Yis'rael."

22. And of Dan, he said, "Dan is a cub 1482 of a lion 738: he shall leap 2187 from Bashan 1316."

23. And of Naph'taliy, he said, "Naph'taliy abounds *7649* in favor *7522*, and is full *4392* of the blessing *1293* of Yahweh: sea-ward *3220* and the south *1864* you shall possess."

24. And of Asher, he said, "Blessed with children be Asher; let him be acceptable 7521 to his brothers, and dip 2881 in oil 8081 his foot 7272.

25. Of iron 1270 and bronze 5178 be his door bolts 4515; and as your days, your strength 1679."

26. None *369* is like the El *410* of Yeshurun *3484*, Who rides upon *7392* the sky as one who helps you *5828*, in His majesty *1346* on the clouds *7834*.

27. Your refuge 4585 is the Elohey 430 of old 6924, from under the arms everlasting: and He shall drive out 1644 from before you the hated enemy; saying, "Destroy 8045 them!"

28. Shall dwell Yis'rael in safety 983 alone 910: the fountain 5869 of Yaaqob upon a land of corn 1715 and new wine 8492; also his skies shall <u>drop down</u> 6201 dew 2919.

29. Happy 835 are you, Yis'rael: who is like you, O people saved by Yahweh, the shield 4043 of your help 5828, and that is the sword of your majesty 1346! Will be found liars 3584 your hated enemies to you; and you, upon their <u>high places</u> 1116 shall tread 1869.

Chapter 34

1. And went up Mosheh from the plains *6160* of Moab, to the mountain of Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, that is over before Yericho. And showed to him Yahweh all the land of Gilead unto Dan;

2. and all Naph'taliy, and the land of Eph'rayim and Menashsheh, and all the land of Yahudah unto the western *314* sea,

3. and the Negeb *5045* and the round *3603* of the valley of Yerecho, the city of palm trees *8558*, unto Tsoar.

4. And said Yahweh to him, "This is the land that I swore to Ab'raham, to Yits'chaq, and to Yaaqob, saying, 'To your seedline I give it.' I have caused you to see it with your eyes, but to there you shall not pass over."

5. So died there Mosheh, servant of Yahweh, in the land of Moab, according to the Word *6213* of Yahweh.

6. And He buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, in front of Beyth-Peor *1047*: but does not know any man of his sepulcher *6900* unto this day.

7. And Mosheh was a hundred and twenty years of age when he died: his eye was not dim 3543 nor his strength 3893 fled away 5127.

8. And wept *1058* the children of Yis'rael for Mosheh in the plain of Moab thirty days: so ended *8552* the days of weeping *1065* and mourning *60* for Mosheh.

9. And Yahshua son of Nun was full of the spirit 7307 of wisdom 2451; because had laid 5564 Mosheh his hands upon him: and listened to him the children of Yis'rael, and did that which commanded Yahweh by Mosheh.

10. And did not arise a prophet since unto Yis'rael like Mosheh, that knew Yahweh face to face,

11. in all the signs and wonders which sent Yahweh to do in the land of Mits'rayim to Par'oh, and to all his servants, and to all his land,

12. and in all that Mighty 2389 Hand, and in all the great reverence 4172 which showed Mosheh in the sight of all Yisrael.

CHAPTER 34 NOTES

This last eulogy for Mosheh really gets to me. To speak to Yahweh directly, to me, is more than an adam could bear. I can only imagine the fear Yis'rael felt when Yahweh spoke from the mountain. I can fully understand why they asked Mosheh to speak with Yahweh for them. I am overwhelmed when the Holy Spirit speaks to me, and the whole presence of Yahweh would be too much in my present imperfect form as a lowly adam.
